AGENDA - PRT/PASS/GC MEETING

- GC Update Erin shared some details from the August GC meeting, including an update on classroom furniture (music risers) and a recent grant we received. Funds from this grant must be spent by December 2022.
- II. PASS Update PASS gave a brief Knowledge-a-Thon update, including a goal of \$10,000. The Knowledge-a-Thon will coincide with Field Day in May 2023. Families will receive communication about this fundraiser beginning 4/1/23. Jen shared a brief endowment update.

Safety Updates - There have been numerous safety updates and new policies this school year. Exterior doors will be locked 24/7. Classroom doors will be locked while students are in the classroom. Bathroom breaks and work time is coordinated to provide additional safety measures. There was a safety drill this morning with students.

Budget Update - CKCS received a grant from Dane County Human Services for \$20,000 to be used on mental health services. Some of this money has been used to send our social worker and counselor to mental health focused conferences.

Enrollment - We currently have 419 students enrolled at CKCS, with 33 Kindergarten students.
