IV. Director's Report (Rick)

Enrollment request was sent to the district.

There will be an update on the middle and elementary school scheduled by our February meeting.

Budget committee - working on prioritizing which FTE to ask for, there will not be cuts next year.

Enrollment update - enrollment window is Jan. 9-Feb. 14. Lottery date will be first or second week in March. The district was able to give us a list of current families that have incoming kindergarteners so we can assure they sign up for CKCS, if they wish to.

Hiring - no updates

Referendum - Rick met with a moving company to get the process started. There may be a need for parents to help unpack classrooms, more information to come closer to the move.

V. Board topics

- A. Dialogue CKCS Strategic Plan / GC Annual Goals (Rick)
We reviewed the "Supporting and Empowering Staff" goal that GC will work on a document/process for communication between parents and teachers. This would include ways to address various concerns, strategies to resolve conflicts, expectations/parameters for appropriate communication. One idea was to create a

code of conduct for parents. Rick suggests creating a group of parents and staff to focus on this topic. We will consider this goal and discuss further at upcoming meetings

The “Equitable Allocation of Resources” - this goal will include that the Budget committee will make FTE requests from the district to address the school’s needs.

We plan to vote on these goals at the February meeting. (This is occurring later than usual due to the charter contract review that was needed in the fall).

We will consider having the goals as a recurring agenda item to continue to discuss these throughout the year.

Erin and Melissa, this was created to be a guide for GC members. There was a discussion of the term length, this will be looked at in the bylaws. Please send suggestions/comments to Erin or Melissa. We will look at changing the “teacher representative” to “curriculum coordinator”.
