Virtual Plus is currently focusing on learning/educational supports and engagement for students who are struggling with virtual learning, with a strong emphasis on literacy.

Grades 3-5: 1:30-3 Tuesday-Thursday (20 spots) Grades 6-8: 2:30-3:45 Tuesday-Thursday (30 spots) School transportation is available for Virtual Plus. Virtual Plus

started Tuesday, November 10th. 17-20% of students grades 3-5 are enrolled in Virtual Plus at CKCS.

Equity Work - Recently staff have been focusing on biases in our curriculum. For example, examining different perspectives in history that typically have been previously overlooked in our curriculum.

Operating Budget - VASD has frozen budgets until further notice, but CKCS has not been drastically affected. Most of the CKCS budget was satisfied through the referendum/building move funds. District funded items so far this year total \$9496 and include our current math curriculum pilot program.

Enrollment - current enrollment 415 students

Referendum Update

A drop ceiling in the new elementary cafeteria has been added to improve acoustic and lighting in that space. Interior signage to be installed. Exterior signage directing community members to refrain from outdoor spaces during school hours to be installed.

V. Board topics

- A. Dialogue: Math Curriculum Update (Nicole) First quarter wrapped up and Mrs. Boedeker reached out to all elementary teachers for feedback on the pilot program so far this school year. Strengths:
 - Lessons are bringing a context to math. Students are seeing the application of math in everyday situations.
 - Teachers and students like the iTools and hands-on manipulatives.
 - Asking students to explain their thinking has been a good and needed challenge. Our students struggled with this at the beginning of the year, but are improved throughout the first quarter.
 - Improved student engagement
 - Math vocabulary
 - Homework and Remembering appropriate amount of practice but is not overwhelming
 - Younger grades love the Puzzled Penguin Next Steps:
 - More Professional Development for staff
 - The Math Curriculum Committee will be meeting in the coming months to review the pilot program.
 - Explore more differentiation opportunities and how it fits within this new curriculum.

Library behavioral expectations will also be removed. Parent behavioral expectations to be added. GC should review the Parent Handbook with suggested changes prior to December's meeting.
