Second Semester Reopening Plan

Option 1: In-person and Concurrent Virtual Instruction

- Students attend in-person 2 full days/week
- Students learn from home 3 days/week. Monday will be asynchronous and related arts will be encompassed into the Tuesday-Friday school days.
- For the most part, students will stay with their current teachers (minimal shifting possible)
- Priority is to keep families across all grade levels together on the same days
- Start times will likely be roughly 8:30a-3:30p a letter (email) will be sent to CKCS families once this has been finalized with the school district.
- CKCS needs all surveys returned before assigning students/families to days they'll be attending in-person
- CKCS Small groupings -
 - Different grade level groupings pose a challenge. Zoom may be a solution to allow for these small groupings
 - Strategic on not mixing grade levels to reduce the mixing of students
 - Each grade at CKCS can be treated as a mini-cohort - some grouping between classes may be possible
- Students learning from home will participate and be included in the classroom learning

- May be altering drop-off location for elementary students so bus students and car drop-off students enter CKCS through separate doors
- Parent volunteers in the classroom will be determined by the district and is still unlikely in order to keep the number of individuals in the classroom as limited as possible

Option 2: Virtual learning only (18% of students chose this option)

 Students who chose Virtual Learning for first semester will now have the option to rejoin CKCS in-person or virtually (rather than attending virtually at Country View)

Equity Work - meeting weekly with a planning group for CKCS and have been meeting with staff. Recently discussed making connections with all students in a virtual setting.

CKCS PD Day - February 18

Mr. Kisting recommends the cancellation of this year's February professional development day to allow for an instructional time with students. Teachers can do PD on asynchronous Mondays. This day would then be a typical synchronous school day.

Joleen motioned to have a regular school day on February 18 and cancel February's CKCS professional development day for this 2020-2021 school year. Erin seconded the motion. Unanimously passed.

- C. Dialogue: Outreach Committee Update (Lauren, Jorja) Met on Monday, November 30. The tentative kick-off for the Kindergarten recruitment season will be January 12. Working to organize footage (and film new footage) to show to prospective families. Organizing virtual tours this year, due to the COVID pandemic (no in-person tours/Q&A sessions will take place this year). Flyer created to post around the area to advertise CKCS enrollment. Parents can sign-up for virtual tours by contacting the CKCS office. Postcards will be mailed to all incoming Kindergarten students around January 12 (Kindergarten recruitment kickoff). Nicole is helping put together a narrated powerpoint of Direct Instruction to send to prospective families. Second powerpoint of a virtual school building tour is also being created.

Section 11 of the Contract has specific language regarding governing board members and preference that may be given to their students regarding enrollment. This language is taken directly from DPI. Who are "Governing Board Members"? There are three leadership groups at CKCS - currently, PRT is not identified as a governing board in the contract. PASS and Governing Council members are elected by the parent body. PRT leadership is not elected by the parent body. PASS would like to update the definition of our governing boards to include all three parent leadership groups at CKCS (PASS, GC & PRT). Joleen will be emailing the PASS proposed definition of "governing board member" prior to the next GC meeting. PASS will be voting on this updated definition

at their January meeting.

Process to recommend governing board member preference for student enrollment to be discussed at January's Governing Council meeting to be added to GC Bylaws. Joleen will send the definition of the governing board member, a proposed process for enrollment preference recommendation and a proposed form for requesting this enrollment preference recommendation. GC should review these and be prepared for January's meeting to discuss and potentially vote on adding this process to our bylaws.
