LEARNERS

(Students, Parents, Staff)

Inspire learners to be passionate, curious and motivated thinkers who take charge of their own development and their engagement in school and the community.

GOAL

For the 2017-18 school year, teachers will work with students and parents to develop a “Student Profile” and at least one “Learning Path”. These will both be entered into and used in the Epiphany Program.

EDUCATION & TEACHING

Attract, develop and maintain high quality staff who will prepare CKCS students for future success through teaching leadership skills and the ability to think creatively, adapt, and evaluate.

GOAL

All students K-2 will meet the grade level benchmark on the 2018 Spring PALS assessment. All students in grades 3-8 scoring at or below the 50th percentile on the 2017 Fall MAP Reading and Math Assessments will exceed their projected growth on the 2018 Spring MAP Reading and Math Assessments. Strategies used throughout the school year will specifically focus on addressing the needs of our students of color.

LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

Create and maintain a welcoming, safe, healthy, and supportive environment that consists of purposefully resourced and inspiring physical and virtual spaces for all learners.

GOAL

For the 2017-18 school year, we will increase the percentage of students that report feeling safe “Always” or “Often” based on the spring 2018 CKCS School Climate Survey. Strategies used throughout the school year will specifically focus on addressing the needs of our students of color.

MARKETING & DEVELOPMENT

To establish and develop an enviable global reputation through effective marketing and communication to internal and external stakeholders.

GOAL

The Governing Council Outreach Committee will create greater awareness of the Verona Area CKCS program through the development of a video highlighting the school’s unique educational attributes.
