**VASD Strategic Framework** - new five-year framework starts 2023-24 school year. Developed by VASD with input from community. District sent out an email with more information.

**Week of Learning -** Responsive classroom training funded by PRT and carryover budget funds.

**Budget** - CKMS had \$2400 in Carry Over Fund. \$1600 was used to purchase CKCS laminator (pre-approved in May). \$800 remains. .

**Enrollment** - two remaining middle school spots have been offered. Full enrollment for K-5 for the upcoming 2023-24 school year.

**Hiring -** Several district hire updates. Special Education FTE reduced from 2.5 to 2.0 by the district, but district added 1.0 FTE Special Education Assistant to offset. One CKCS exclusive sub was hired (one open position remaining) and Reading Corp Tutor also hired.

- B. Middle School Grading scale discussion (Steph)

  CKCS' middle school grading scale is different from the high school. Our MS teachers would like us to consider aligning with the high school grading scale. Steph confirmed if approved, able to make changes in PowerSchool prior to Sept. Lauren motioned to approve changing the MS grading scale to align with HS grading scale. Jorja seconded. Passed unanimously.

- D. Contract Renewal Committee Update (Lauren/Steph) CKCS charter contract owned by PASS. A team including Steph, the PASS president and three parents formed to assist with contract renewal. Team has determined the timeline and objectives for work on contract renewal. Goal to submit to superintendent and DPI for review spring 2024 and to present to the school board fall 2024. The new contract would start July 1, 2025. Charter renewal occurs every 5 years.
