

#### **BOOK FAIR**

The fall book fair is over and it was a great success!! We sold \$6,891.77 worth of books and merchandise.

Scholastic allows us to take 25% of sales in cash or 50% (plus bonuses) in Scholastic Dollars. For the past few years, we have been taking our profits as Scholastic Dollars because we can use Scholastic Dollars to purchase the Weekly Readers and other academic materials that are currently being used in our K-5 and 7th grade classrooms. We also purchase books for the school library, classroom libraries and students (summer book program), so we get a lot more bang for our buck!

With bonuses, we earned \$3,666.35 in Scholastic Dollars from this fair alone! We had Scholastic Dollars that we carried over from last year's fairs as well. After purchasing \$850 worth of books for the classroom libraries and paying for the Weekly Readers and other curriculum tools for the 2019-20 school year, we have \$4,521.95 Scholastic Dollars remaining.

This is awesome! It will allow us to purchase the materials for the 2020-21 school year and additional books for the school and classroom libraries as we move into our new space next year and the elementary and middle school libraries are split. It also means that we can use our Dollars earned from the spring book fair to once again purchase a book for each student to help with the "summer slide".

## Tri4Schools Grant



PRT applied for a grant from Tri4Schools and our grant was selected! Tri4Schools purchased 2 soccer goals for CKCS that will move with us to our new space. The goals arrived, were put together and are already being put to good use by our kiddos - despite the cold, snow and mud. Thank you Tri4Schools!
