

COLOR RUN

The Color Run Fundraiser event is now behind us and we are so grateful for the many generous people who donated! Our goal was to raise \$15,000 with this event in order to minimize the number of "asks" throughout the year. As of the run we had \$12,003 raised, which is 80% of our goal. We are tallying last minute offline donations and will have a final number for you soon. Given our expenses, we get to keep 83% of the funds raised. In comparison, the Great American fundraiser only gave us 40% of the money.
