### new collaborations

My Right To Hear continued to collaborate with major organizations that share the goal of helping children in need in the Middle East. Those collaborations help increase the outreach of our missions, whether by logistic or monetary support.

#### **MBC** Hope



MBC Hope is the Social Responsibilities arm for MBC Media Group, which is the largest Media Group in the Middle East and North Africa.

In 2023, My Right To Hear and MBC Hope signed a collaboration agreement where MBC will help raise funding for My Right To Hear and expand its media presence, in order to reach and treat more children in the Middle East. My Right To Hear will also treat children of foreign residents in KSA as well, as part of the agreement.

### Syrian American Medical Society (SAMS)



SAMS is a non-profit, non-political, organization based in the United State and is comprised of thousands of Syrian-American healthcare professionals. It is the largest provider of healthcare services in North Syria and to Syrian refugees in neighboring countries.

The collaboration between My Right To Hear and SAMS in 2022 led to the establishment of the first cochlear implant program in North Syria with complete domiciliation of the services, serving a population of more than 5 million people.

More than 30 children were treated in North Syria during 2023 as part of the collaboration.

By the end of 2023, My Right To Hear and SAMS established a cochlear implant in program in Lebanon as well, which started operating in 2024.




### achievements

#### **Cochlear implant surgery**

During 2023, a total of **90 children** with severe hearing loss were successfully treated and were able to hear and talk, go to school, and participate in normal activities for children their age. Those include:

- Palestine 70 children
- North Syria 20 children



#### **Hearing Aids**

During 2023, a total of **1,200 hearing aids** were distributed to children with hearing loss in Palestine.

- Gaza: 500 hearing aids (including children who lost their hearing as a result of war)
- West Bank: 700 hearing aids
