

CAMP IS ON FOR 2020!!!

Hi! We are very excited to announce that Summer Camp will start on June 1st!

For the past 20 years Safety America has had one of the most successful summer camps in Fort Bend County. One of the reasons our parents love the camp is our drop-in policy. While most camps require you to sign-up for 2-weeks, at SA you can simply show up unannounced and drop your kid off. We always offer the flexibility to sign-up daily or weekly.

Unfortunately, due to the virus pandemic, we must modify our registration process as follows:

- At this time, we will limit the number of children that can attend our camp each day. We will accept students only on a first come, first serve basis. Therefore, it would be wise to pre-register your child well in advance.
- If something does come up the last minute and you must drop your child off at the camp, first call us to confirm that we have available space. Then you will need to fill out the registration form on the SA website and email it to us or get on your computer or phone and register electronically. We cannot allow in-facility registration for safety reasons.

In order to maintain the safety of our campers, parents and staff and help prevent the spread of COVID-19 (Coronavirus), we are implementing the following guidelines:

Safety America Karate Summer Camp COVID-19 Safety Procedures:

Parent & Camper Guidelines:

- First and foremost, if any of the below apply to your child, please keep them home.
 - If they have had a cough or fever within 14 days.
 - If they have been living with someone who is sick.
 - If they have been in contact with anyone that has had Covid-19.
- Camp spots will be limited, so **PLEASE PRE-REGISTER ONLINE** to ensure your child's spot in camp.
- Parents will **NOT** be allowed in the facility at any time (camp hours, pick up, or drop off time).
- Parents will be required to drop off their child for camp.
- When dropping off your child for camp each day:
 - A member of our staff will walk to your car and take your child's temperature using a forehead thermometer. If your child experiences a temperature, they will not be allowed inside the facility and may schedule a make-up day by calling when they are well.
- All campers entering the facility will be required to wash their hands or use hand sanitizer immediately.
 - We will have hand sanitizer available at the gym, however, this is not a substitute for regular hand washing.
- Campers will be divided into groups (based on age) that will remain consistent throughout the camp day to maintain minimal or no contact with children from other groups.
- Campers will be taking frequent breaks throughout the camp day to sanitize or wash their hands.
- All water fountains and vending machines will be closed. Campers must bring their own water bottle and lunch to camp.
- There will be no field trips.

Our Camp Staff will be:

- Taking students temperature upon their arrival to the gym, before they enter the facility.
- Cleaning all equipment that was used by campers between camp rotations and after each camp day with our medical grade cleaner, which we already use throughout the facility.
- Disinfecting all chairs, door handles, bathrooms and frequently touched surfaces with our medical grade cleaner at regular intervals.
- Cleaning and disinfecting tables and chairs after lunch.
- Our camp staff will only be allowed to come to work if feeling completely well, and their temperatures will be taken daily.
- Coaches will be maintaining social distancing. They will wear a mask when unable to social distance due to safety purposes.

This is an extremely difficult time and we are doing our best during this complex and ever-changing environment. We are thankful to be a part of such a loyal community committed to the health and wellness of their families.
