# Safety America's Ninja Warrior Spring Break Camp - 2020

## **Camp Dates & Times**

- 1 Camp starts Monday, March 9th and ends Friday, March 13th.
- 2 Camp starts at 9:00am each morning and ends at 3:00pm sharp.
- 3 You can sign-up on a daily basis (assuming there is room) or pre-register for the week.
- 4 We accept children ages 4 years old to 13 years old.

## Camp Fees

- 1. The daily camp rate is \$40/day.
- 2. If a child pre-registers for the whole week, he/she will receive the weekly discount of \$175/week or \$35/day.
- 3. Extended Care Fee is \$5 for 7-9am, \$5 for 3-4pm, and \$5 from 4-6pm (per child).
- 4. Siblings receive a 10% discount on the daily rate.
- 5. ALL FEES must be paid at time of drop-off NOT at pick-up. NO Refunds.

## Lunch/Break

- 1. Lunch break will be around 11:30 each day.
- 2. Kids should bring their own lunch (except Mondays Pizza Day) & drink each day.
- 3. Safety America does not provide any snacks, drinks or cutlery. Campers must bring their own.
- 4. While there is no designated snack time, campers are always allowed to sit out from an activity to rest, get water, or have snack (if they brought one).
- 5. Any food allergies/restrictions/special needs should be reported to the Summer Camp Staff at the time of registration.

## Check-In & Check-Out

- 1. Check-in time at Safety America Karate will be at 9:00 am or later.
- 2. Parents must go in the front facility to drop-off and sign-in kids. Please do not drop your child off at the front door and let them walk in by themselves.
- 3. Campers must be signed in and signed out by a parent/legal guardian listed on the child's registration form. If an individual not listed on the registration form is picking up a child (carpooling, going with a friend, etc.) the parent/legal guardian must submit a note prior to the designated person picking up the child.
- 4. Check out will be at Safety America Karate promptly at 3 pm. Parents must go in the front facility to pick-up kids.
- 5. Parents who do not pick-up kids by 3:00 pm will be charged according to our aftercare rates:
  - a. (\$5/child from 3-4 pm & \$5/child from 4-6 pm).
- 6. Camp fees MUST be paid before or at the time of drop off or the child will not be allowed in camp.

## **Dress Code/What to Bring to Camp**

- 1. Campers should wear T-shirt and/or comfortable athletic clothing & sneakers each day.
- 2. Please do NOT wear flip-flops, sandals, or crocs to camp. If a child does not have close-toed shoes, they may not be able to participate in certain activities.
- 3. We recommend campers bring a water bottle to camp each day.
- Cell Phones/Electronic devices are prohibited during camp hours of 9am to 3pm. If a child brings a cell phone or electronic device, we will ask that they be kept in their cubbies with their lunch/other belongings.
- 5. Safety America is not responsible for any lost or stolen items brought to camp.

### **Kid Behavior Code**

All campers are expected to follow basic rules of behavior, including respecting themselves, others, and equipment/materials. Camp Coaches/Staff will review our behavior policies with all campers at the start of each day. Campers will not be forced to do anything they do not want to do. Kids who do not want to take part in any activity may want to bring a book to read. Cell phones and electronic devices will not be allowed during the camp hours of 9am to 3pm, even for those campers not participating in an activity. We will not tolerate disrespectful behavior, bullying, foul language, or violence of any sort.

#### First Incident:

During the camp, if child behaviorally acts inappropriately as determined by Summer Camp Staff, the child will sit out for 5 minutes. This is their first warning.

#### Second Incident:

If the same child continues to behaviorally act inappropriately after their first warning has been given, child will sit out for 10 minutes. This is their second warning.

#### Third Incident:

If the same child has not changed their behavioral actions as a result of the first two warnings, the child sits out for the rest of the day.

After the third warning the parent will be notified of their child's inappropriate behavior upon pickup at the end of the camp day. If the child's inappropriate behavior continues the next day, a parent will be called and the child will sit out from camp activities.

<u>NOTE</u>: Safety America has a zero-tolerance bullying/hitting policy. If a child is seen bullying or hitting another camper, the child will immediately sit out from all camp activities, a parent will be called to come and pick up the child, and the child will not be allowed back at camp. There are NO REFUNDS if your child is suspended from camp.

### **Child Safety & Accidents**

- 1. Kids playing at a "Sports Camp" may incur minor cuts, bumps & bruises.
- 2. Minor injuries will be reported to parent at the time of pick-up.
- 3. More serious injuries will result in a call to the parent.
