The **Qualsafe Level 3 Award in Adult Basic Life Support and Automated External Defibrillation (RQF)** is designed for people who have a specific interest or responsibility at work, or in voluntary and community activities, to provide basic life support (BLS) when dealing with an emergency situation which may also involve using a defibrillator (AED).
