As the season begins, the greenhouse frame is coming down and moving to the back field, leaving behind the bugs and parasites that have plagued us for the last few years. That's why greenhouses have to move. They provide warmth and shelter to tender and heat loving plants, but it's harder to clear out bugs under the plastic

so sooner or later, the plastic comes off, the trellis is moved and the farmer gets to start afresh on a new site just in time for a new season of growing for the CSA.

The basic line up is in place for the new season with some exciting additions. The 22 week summer box program beginning in early June and running until the end of October is still the mainstay of the Quarry Farm CSA. We are adding some new vegetable options to the program, and there will be more flowers since they were so well received last year. The bread program and the jar program will continue, but this year we are offering half shares for all three programs. You will also be able to sign up for Deb's granola and a new honey program since several of you have asked for honey.

Last year, several generous sponsors allowed us to provide veggie boxes to low income families. This year, we've added the option to sponsor a family to our registration. Please let us know if you would like more information about this option.

We plan to run the winter program again but will be back to you with details in early July.
