COURSE INFORMATION

Evidence and exhibits are the backbone to criminal investigations. Without these cases cannot be investigated or prosecuted. Evidence and exhibits help to establish the facts surrounding the report, identify witnesses or suspects, corroborate other information and assist in preparing and presenting cases to the court to determine innocence or guilt.

This course has been designed for any individual involved in gathering, managing, handling or reviewing evidence as part of criminal investigations and proceedings. It is therefore suitable for investigators, enforcement officers, evidence gatherers, disclosure officers, intelligence officers, prosecutors, team leaders and managers.
