Explaining the Caution

You do not have to say anything

This means that you do not have to answer the questions asked. If you decide you do not want to answer my questions please say 'no comment' so we know that you have heard, understood and do not wish to answer the question.

But it may harm your defence if you do not mention when questioned something which you later rely on in court.

This means that if you decide not to answer my questions in this interview but decide to answer the same or similar questions at court, and the court believes you could have reasonably provided the answer today, the court can draw a negative inference.

Anything you do say may be given as evidence

This means that anything you say in this interview can be used as evidence. The interview can be played in court or a written transcript of the interview read to the court.
