

STREET-SCENE ENFORCEMENT: PATROLLING AND FIXED PENALTY NOTICE ESSENTIALS

COURSE OVERVIEW

Streetscene enforcement is essential for maintaining clean, safe, and welcoming public spaces. This course equips Enforcement Officers with the knowledge and practical skills required to issue Fixed Penalty Notices (FPNs) confidently and correctly. Participants will learn how to identify and address offences such as littering and breaches of Public Spaces Protection Orders, ensuring compliance with local regulations and promoting community standards.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

- Identify the range of streetscene offences that can be addressed through on-the-spot FPNs.
- Understand the evidential standards required to support enforcement actions.
- Maintain comprehensive and contemporaneous records to ensure accuracy and accountability.
- Evaluate key considerations before issuing a FPN to ensure fairness and compliance.
- Apply correct procedures for issuing Fixed Penalty Notices confidently and professionally.
- Demonstrate awareness of the requirements under the Police and Criminal Evidence Act 1984 and Regulation of Investigatory Powers Act 2000 when conducting patrols.
