International best practice suggests that all investigative interviews for public or private purposes should be based on the PEACE Model. This Model was developed to increase public confidence in law enforcement officers' investigation involving the interviews of suspects.

There are five phases to the PEACE interview model which combine with advanced investigative techniques, along with a deep understanding of motivation, psychology and human dynamics to achieve the recovery of best evidence.

AUDIENCE

This course has been designed for individuals who wish to enhance their investigative interviewing skills when interviewing with suspects.
