OBTAINING WITNESS STATEMENTS IN CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIONS

Those involved in criminal investigations will at some stage be required to obtain a witness statement as part of their investigations. These witness statements need to be of a high enough quality to identify other lines of enquiry, interview suspects or build prosecution files.

- Identify when a Victim Personal Statement or Impact Statement for Business should be obtained.
