COMMUNITY PROTECTION NOTICES

COURSE INFORMATION

The Community Protection Notice (CPN) was introduced as part of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014. The Act aimed to fill gaps left in earlier legislation, strengthening enforcement powers and making the tools available to counter anti-social behaviour simpler for officers to use.

AUDIENCE

This course is suitable for any individual who may use the CPN as part of their investigative toolkit to tackle anti-social behaviour. This includes investigators, team leaders and managers from the police, local authority and housing providers with delegated powers.

COURSE LENGTH AND DELIVERY METHODS

The course is a half-day course and provides 3 CPD credits.

It can be delivered virtually or in-person.

By the end of this course, participants will be able to:

- Understand the legislation surrounding the use of CPNs.
- Identify when to use CPN powers.
- Know the process surrounding the service of a CPN.
