

Commercial Duty of Care: Understanding Your Responsibilities Course

All businesses have a duty to ensure that their waste is handled and managed appropriately from production through to disposal. Where a business fails in their duty of care they risk unlimited fines and a criminal record.

Within this course we will look at the principle of right waste in the right place.

In this course we will identify what your responsibilities are and how you can ensure you are complying with the law.

This course is a half-day course and can be delivered both virtually and in-person.

This course has been designed specifically for those within the private sector who produce, transfer or transport controlled waste, whether you work in a shop, restaurant, as a tradesperson or as a waste collector.
