ADVANCED FLY TIPPING: INVESTIGATION AND ENFORCEMENT

COURSE INFORMATION

Fly tipping is a criminal offence and carries significant penalties of up to five years imprisonment. It harms the environment, creates safety hazards and affects communities.

This course has been designed to provide an enhanced level of understanding in respect of the investigation and enforcement of fly tipping.

AUDIENCE

This course has been designed for individuals from Local Authorities and other government organisations who are involved in the investigation, enforcement and prosecution of fly tipping and householder duty of care offences including Environmental Crime Officers, Waste Management Officers, Community Wardens, Community Safety Officers, Intelligence Officers, Team Leaders, Managers and Lawyers.

COURSE LENGTH AND DELIVERY METHODS

The course is a two-day course.

It can be delivered virtually or in-person.

By the end of this course, participants will be able to:

- Understand what fly tipping is and its impact on communities and the environment.
- Identify and categorise fly tipping incidents.
- Consider how to build effective partnerships to reduce and prevent fly tipping.
- Know effective techniques for investigating fly tipping and householder duty of care offences.
- Explore methods of gathering intelligence and evidence to reduce and detect fly tipping.
- Understand the legal frameworks and enforcement action in respect of fly tipping and householder duty of care offences.
