Then he told them a parable: "Look at the fig tree and all the trees; 3as soon as they sprout leaves you can see for yourselves and know that summer is already near. So also, when you see these things taking place, you know that the kingdom of God is near. Luke 21:29-31

Ah! Summer is finally here and everything will slow down. Right? I remember thinking that each spring when my children were in school. Then summer sports and Vacation Bible School and other summer activities would soon make my schedule just as frantic as ever. Now, one would think after Easter and Mother's Day and our 155th Anniversary celebration that church would slow down and we could just relax all summer. Right? Wrong! The Kingdom of God is near and this is no time to take it slow.

The first day of June begins with an Ascension service. Ascension, the day our Lord Jesus rose to sit at the right hand of the Father, takes place 40 days after Easter. That means it always falls on the Thursday before and is celebrated on the 7th Sunday of Easter. We acknowledge our Lord's Ascension in our Call to Worship, the Prayer of the Day, and the Preface of the Great Thanksgiving.

The next Sunday, the 8th of June, is Pentecost. Be sure to wear your red this day. Pentecost is observed 50 days after Easter. This period is also known as the "Great 50 Days" and is a time of celebrating the Resurrection of Jesus Christ and the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Pentecost is considered the "birthday of the Church" and the beginning of the Church's mission to spread the Gospel.

No rest yet for the very next Sunday, the 15th, we celebrate the Holy Trinity. As we give thanks and glory to the Great Three-in-One and One-in-Three, we add a Holy Trinity Litany and a special Thanksgiving at the Table to our service. The Kingdom of God has indeed come near.

Oh, yes, and as we live our faith through the month of June, we cannot forget our Synod Assembly on June 5-7. This year is especially important as Bishop Candea retires and we elect a new Bishop. Pray for our voting members to discern God's will as we make decisions that will affect our church for the next six years. Join us in person or online as we continue to be the church this June and beyond.
