Our period of repentance and lamenting comes to an end on April 13<sup>th</sup>, Palm Sunday, the Sunday of Our Lord's Passion and the beginning of Holy Week. This is what we have been waiting for all year. The holiest week for us, our greatest festival because we are an Easter people. We proclaim a crucified and risen Lord. This is the story of our salvation by the grace of God through the love of Jesus Christ in the power of the Holy Spirit.

We begin the week with our Palm Sunday celebration at 9:30 on April 13<sup>th</sup>. We will join in with a Palm Procession as we sing Hosanna in the highest. On this day we remember our Lord's triumphant entry into Jerusalem on the back of a donkey. We follow along as we read of The Passion of Our Lord According to Luke.

We rest then until Maundy Thursday and the beginning of The Three Days. Our Maundy service begins at 7:00 pm on April 17<sup>th</sup>. On this day our Lord gave us our sacrament of Holy Communion and tonight we receive His body and blood shed for us in remembrance of Him. The service ends with the stripping of the altar as we remember how Christ was stripped of his garments at the hands of the soldiers and was exposed naked to their insults. Within 24 hours of the Last Supper, our Lord will be crucified. We depart in silence to gather in silence on Good Friday.

We come together on Friday at 7:00 pm to witness Christ's crucifixion and Christ's victory over death on that very cross. We pray for the whole world for which Christ died during our Bidding Prayers. We read the Passion of Our Lord According to John. We honor the cross as our sign of forgiveness, healing, and salvation through the Procession of the Cross and the Solemn Reproaches. We depart again in silence to return in glory on Easter morn.



Sunday, April 20<sup>th</sup>, begins our Easter service at 9:30. On this glorious day we can again sing Hallelujah as we are joined together with the risen Christ at the table. We celebrate hope. We celebrate rebirth. We celebrate the steadfast love of God. We celebrate the freely-given grace of God in the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit. Won't you come and join us on this journey to salvation?
