With the start of the New Year here at Immanuel, we embark on a new season in the life of our church. While our attendance is slowly increasing, we are still unable to balance our budget. For several years, we have found it necessary to borrow from our reserves in order to meet our expenditures. Just as in our personal lives we cannot continually spend more than we bring in, the same is true for our church. Simply put, our reserves will run out.

So, our council has authorized our Council President to appoint an Ad Hoc Committee to explore the future possibilities for Immanuel. If you have an interest in serving on such a committee or if you have suggestions or ideas, please contact your president, the pastor, or your other council members. We have already come up with a number of opportunities to explore. We don't wish to scare you; the church is not in immediate danger of having to close its doors. But our financial situation is becoming a matter of urgency and we want to be able to control our future before our future controls us.

In the meantime, we ask that you pray for guidance for our leaders as we look to the future. As we accumulate our information to pay our taxes in the new year, we ask that you reexamine your tithing. And finally, let us all ask ourselves why our church exists. What is our purpose here at Immanuel? What is God doing here? What is God asking us to do? With God's help, may we discern how to continue to serve God's purpose here in our community and our world in this new season of our church. Amen.
