It's called a "prayer chain" because the individual members are "linked" by prayer. The imagery of a chain underscores the strength of God's people who are united in prayer. Those who participate in a prayer chain commit to pray for whatever need arises, when it arises. There is no reward promised; those who pray do so out of concern for others' needs. They know they are entreating a God who hears them if they ask according to His will (1 John 5:14).

How do I join the Prayer Chain?
