With fall in full swing at Freedom, I wanted to take a moment to reflect on our summer quarter of 2025.

By now, you're familiar with the ministry we do—whether it's Breakfast Church, one of our feeding programs, or our clothing distribution efforts. In this letter, I'd like to first introduce you to one of our humble heroes.

Let me introduce you to Jeanette Lindow. Jeanette has a background in addiction, but Jesus got a hold of her life! She has experienced a radical transformation and now uses her time to give back. Jeanette oversees our clothing distribution program, and together with her team, she sorts and distributes hundreds of articles of clothing each month.

Jeanette and her teammate, Sandra, have been faithfully serving for the past year and a half, showing the love of Christ by meeting people's emergency clothing needs. If you would like to donate, we are currently focusing on winter outerwear—coats, hats, gloves, and scarves are greatly appreciated.



Also this summer, the staff from East Hill Church Family joined us for one of our Thursday outreach events. They were given a sobering look at many of the daily needs we encounter. They helped with several projects, including shower truck check-in, hygiene services distribution, lunch preparation and serving, clothing sorting and distribution, community engagement, prayer walking, and wall painting. It was a busy and impactful day—not only for them but for all of us who were touched by their love, care, and service.



Later in the summer, our food pantry began running low. I reached out to my friends at Eagle Creek Foursquare Church, and they graciously organized a food drive. When their team delivered the collected items, we were able to replenish our pantry. We are incredibly grateful for partnerships like this that enable us to continue the work we do. If you'd like to donate to the food pantry or organize a food drive, we would be deeply thankful. Together, we can help address the food insecurity happening right outside our front door.

Most recently, I had the opportunity to lead a national clinic that took veterans on a five-day wilderness rafting and kayaking adventure through the Hells Canyon section of the Snake River.

This was in partnership with an organization called Team River Runner. Their mission is to provide health and healing to wounded and disabled vets through paddle sports. While Team River Runner is not a religious organization, being off the grid with these veterans gave me ample opportunity to share one-on-one about my faith and the good work being done through Freedom.
