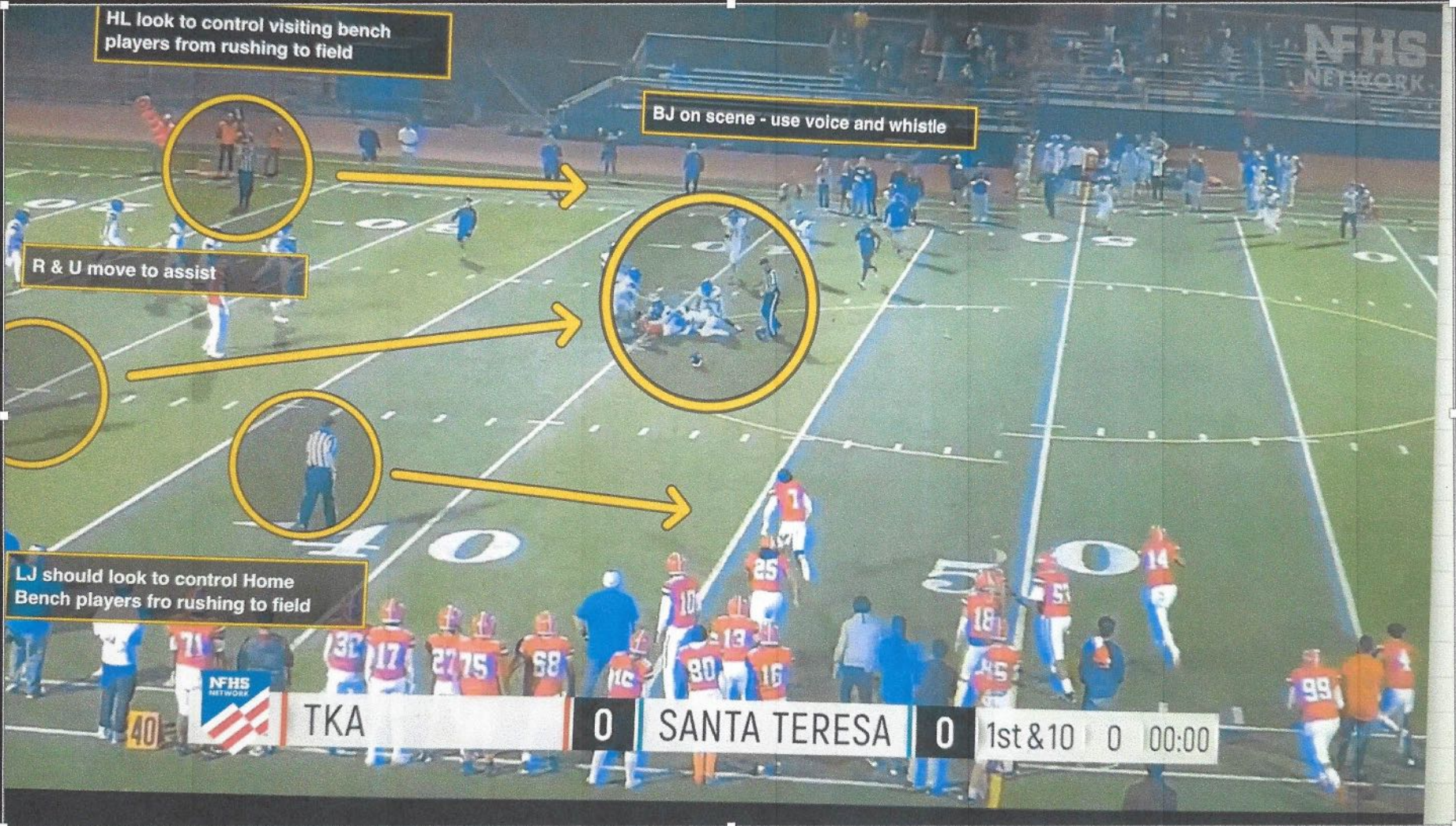

HL look to control visiting bench players from rushing to field

BJ on scene - use voice and whistle

R & U move to assist

LJ should look to control Home Bench players fro rushing to field



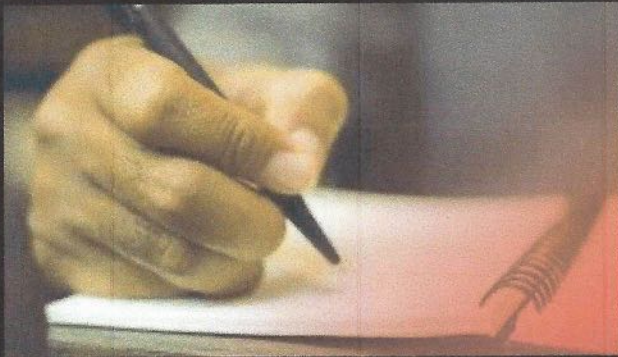


While the Incident is Happening

1. Wings – Keep Your Players Off the Field
2. Use your voice and whistle as necessary
3. Separate any players you can
4. Write involved players numbers down
5. Don't Get Hurt!

Afterwards:

1. As a crew, note all info, time, quarter, score, players #'s involved, and incident itself
2. Report info to both coaches along with any disqualifications



What's Next?

What else do you have to do

1. After game, ensure you and the crew all agree on info (Note: this can be done away from game site)
2. Within 24 hours, you must file a report with CCS
3. A report MUST ALSO be made for all ejections
4. Referee must write an objective, facts relevant narrative (use any pertinent rules reference as needed)
5. The following morning- run the report (ejections and incidents) by your crew chief and either Tom Gersey, Phil Beltran or Randy Frey for approval before submitting to CCS
6. By the following afternoon, file your report with the CCS at:
