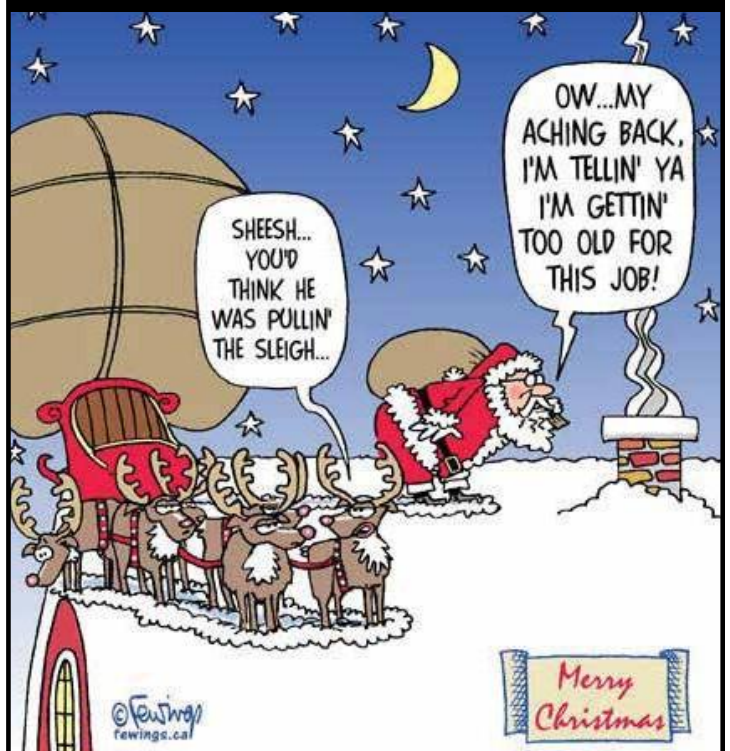

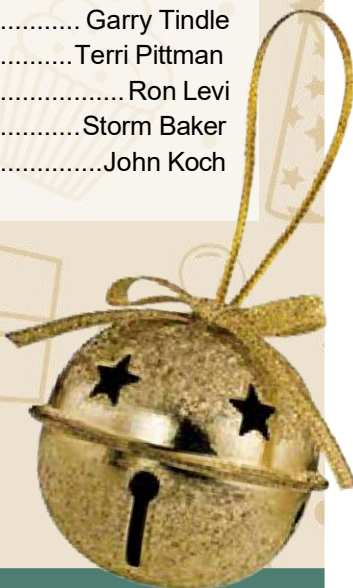

### The Traditions of Christmas

Many families around the winter holidays put up a tree, whether real or fake. Then they'll spend an afternoon with hot cocoa and Christmas music, putting up ornaments, stringing garland, and topping off the tree with a star or angel.

## Recipe of the Month

### Crispy Ranch Brussels Sprouts (Air fryer Friendly)

#### Ingredients

- 1 pound of Brussels Sprouts
- 1 ½ Hidden Valley Ranch Seasoning
- 2 Tablespoons of Olive Oil Plus more for Garnish
- 1 Tablespoon of Lemon Juice
- Sea Salt for Garnish

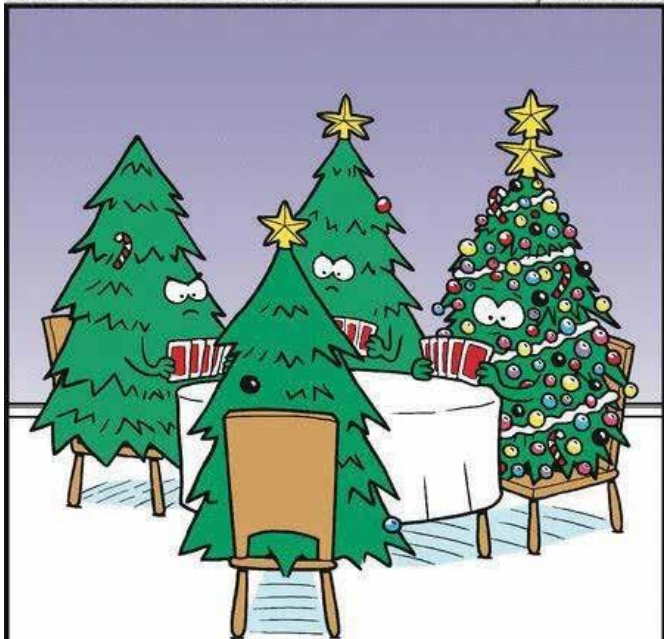
#### Steps

1. Preheat the oven to 425 degrees. Spread the Brussels sprouts out on two baking sheets.
2. Drizzle with the olive oil and sprinkle on the seasoning mix. Toss well to coat with your hands.
3. Roast for 10 minutes. Sprinkle the lemon juice and flip with spatula to toss with the juice and turn the sprouts over.
4. Cook for another 10 minutes or so, until browned and crisp. Remove from oven, drizzle with a little bit of oil and season with sea salt. Serve hot.

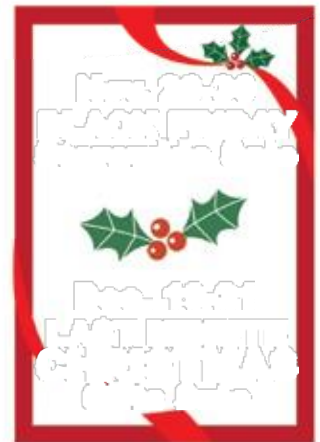

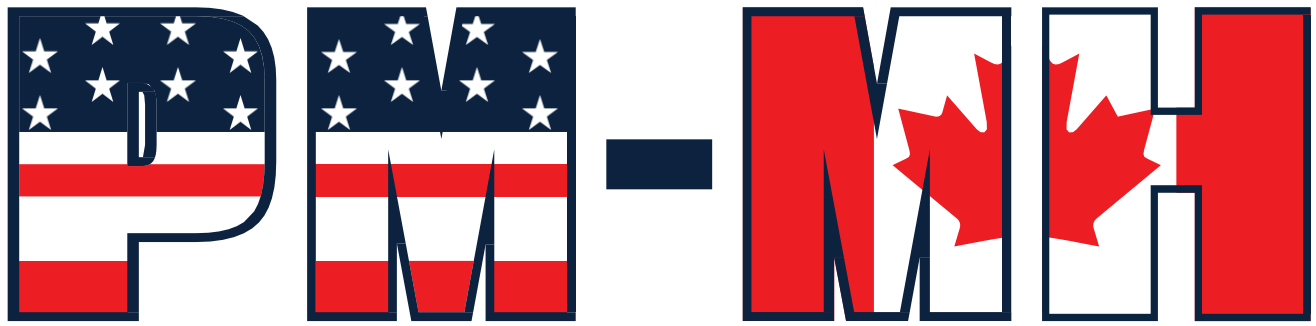
