Remember, site inspections are ongoing, and all rules and regulations will be enforced, especially regarding pet rules and site exterior conditions. Make sure



Recipe of the Month



CHICKEN STEW

by Holly Nilsson

6 servings

In this comforting chicken stew recipe, chunks of tender chicken, hearty root vegetables, and seasonings simmer in a flavorful chicken broth. It's filled with goodness for the ultimate comfort food.

Ingredients

- 1 ½ pounds boneless skinless chicken thighs about 8 thighs, diced 1-inch
- 2 tablespoon olive oil
- 2 carrots diced
- 1 small onion chopped
- 2 ribs celery diced
- 5 tablespoons all-purpose flour divided
- ½ teaspoon dried rosemary
- ½ teaspoon dried thyme leaves
- ¼ teaspoon ground sage
- salt and black pepper to taste
- 1 ½ cups diced potatoes peeled if using russets or baking potatoes
- 1 ½ cups diced sweet potatoes peeled
- ½ red bell pepper finely diced
- ¼ cup white wine
- 4 cups chicken broth or chicken stock
- 1 cup green beans cut into 1-inch pieces, or frozen peas, thawed
- ½ cup heavy whipping cream

Instructions

In a large pot or Dutch oven, brown chicken in 1 tablespoon olive oil (it doesn't have to be cooked through). Remove from pot and set aside. Cook onion, carrot and celery in remaining olive oil for about 3 minutes or until onion is slightly softened. Stir in 3 tablespoons of flour, seasonings and salt & pepper to taste. Cook over medium heat about 2 minutes. Add potatoes, sweet potatoes, red pepper, white wine, browned chicken and broth. Bring to a boil, reduce heat and simmer covered for 30 minutes. Remove lid and stir in green beans and cream. Thicken if desired (below) and simmer an additional 10 minutes uncovered. To thicken: In a mason jar combine remaining 2 tablespoons flour and 1 cup water or broth. Shake very well (ensure there are no lumps) and add a little at a time to boiling stew to reach desired consistency.

Recipe of the Month

Chocolate-Peppermint Cake

Description

This seasonal cake is the ultimate holiday dessert—rich, moist and deeply chocolaty with a cool hint of peppermint in every bite. The batter comes together quickly with pantry staples, while a splash of hot coffee intensifies the cocoa flavor. For a touch of holiday sparkle, a shower of crushed peppermint candies adds extra color and crunch..



Ingredients

Cake

- ½ cup plus 2 tablespoons all-purpose flour
- ½ cup plus 2 tablespoons whole-wheat flour
- ½ cup unsweetened cocoa powder
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- ¾ teaspoon baking soda
- ½ teaspoon salt
- ½ cup granulated sugar
- ½ cup packed light brown sugar
- ½ cup neutral oil, such as vegetable or canola
- ½ cup whole milk
- 2 large eggs
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- ¾ teaspoon peppermint extract
- ½ cup hot strong coffee

Buttercream

- ¾ cup unsalted butter, at room temperature
- 2¼ cups confectioners' sugar, sifted
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- ¼ teaspoon peppermint extract
- ⅛ teaspoon salt
- Crushed hard peppermint candies (optional)

Directions

STEP 1: To prepare cake: Preheat oven to 350°F. Lightly coat a 9-by-13-inch baking pan with cooking spray.

STEP 2: Whisk ½ cup plus 2 tablespoons all-purpose flour, ½ cup plus 2 tablespoons whole-wheat flour, ½ cup cocoa, 1 teaspoon baking powder, ¾ teaspoon baking soda and ½ teaspoon salt in a medium bowl.

STEP 3: In a large bowl, whisk together ½ cup granulated sugar, ½ cup brown sugar, ½ cup oil, ½ cup milk, 2 eggs, 2 teaspoons vanilla and ¾ teaspoon peppermint extract. Whisk in the flour mixture until just combined. Gradually whisk in ½ cup hot coffee until fully incorporated.

STEP 4 Pour the batter into the prepared pan. Bake until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean, 20 to 25 minutes. Cool completely in the pan on a wire rack, about 1 hour.:

STEP 5: Meanwhile, prepare buttercream: Beat ¾ cup butter in a medium bowl with an electric mixer on medium-high speed until fluffy, about 1 minute. Add the sifted confectioners' sugar, 1 teaspoon vanilla, ¼ teaspoon peppermint extract and ⅛ teaspoon salt; beat until smooth and fluffy, about 2 minutes.

STEP 6: Spread the buttercream over the cooled cake. Sprinkle with crushed peppermint candies, if desired.






