## Recipe of the Month



### Homemade Moose Munch

Published: December 5, 2017 | Modified: October 27, 2024

*This homemade moose munch tastes even better than the original! So light, crisp, & buttery, with tender nuts and a hint of chocolate.*

#### Nutritional Information

#### Ingredients

- 2 3-ounce bags microwave popcorn (lightly salted), popped
- 1 cup cashews
- 1 cup whole almonds
- 1/2 cup unsalted butter
- 1 cup light brown sugar, packed
- 1/3 cup dark corn syrup
- 1/2 teaspoon kosher salt
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1/2 teaspoon baking soda
- 2 ounces white chocolate, melted
- 2 ounces dark chocolate, melted

#### Instructions

1. Preheat the oven to 250 degrees F, and lightly grease a baking sheet.
2. Place the popcorn in a large mixing bowl, along with the nuts.
3. Melt the butter in a medium saucepan over low heat.
4. Stir in the brown sugar, corn syrup, and salt.
5. Increase the heat to medium and bring the mixture to a boil, stirring.
6. When the caramel comes to a boil, reduce the heat to medium low and allow to simmer, stirring, for 3 minutes (or until the temperature registers about 235 degrees F on a candy thermometer).
7. Remove the pot from the heat and stir in the vanilla and baking soda (the mixture will foam up).
8. Slowly drizzle the mixture over the popcorn, while stirring/tossing the popcorn to coat it with the hot caramel. (It might be easier if you have a kitchen helper. One can pour while the other stirs.)
9. When the popcorn is well coated with caramel, spread it out in an even layer on a greased baking sheet.
10. Bake for 1 hour.
11. Allow to cool completely, then drizzle with melted white chocolate and melted dark chocolate.
12. Let the chocolate set, then break the moose munch into chunks and package up in mason jars, paper boxes, or cello bags for gifting an even layer on a greased baking sheet.

It is said that farmers in Nebraska where a family couldn't repay the loan and the bank was going to Auction off the farm. As those who were there remember it, the auctioneer began with a piece of equipment. The first bid was 5-cents. When someone else tried to raise that bid, he was requested not to do so – forcibly. Item after item got only one or two bids. All were ridiculously low. The proceeds for that first "Penny Auction" were \$5.35, which the bank was supposed to accept to pay off the loan. The Desertscape Penny Sale isn't based on a foreclosure of our homes or farms. We do bring items from our homes to be sold for a Penny. It is a lot of fun and there is much to bid on.


