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## Week One

Reflection	What parts of life feel unsteady right now?
Prayer Prompt	God, be my rock and my refuge when everything shifts.
The Foundation That Holds	Isaiah 2816
Reflection	What helps you stay grounded in uncertain times?
Prayer Prompt	Jesus, help me trust in the sure foundation you have laid.
Christ, Our Cornerstone	Ephesians 219-22
Reflection	How does Christ hold the church together?
Prayer Prompt	Build us up, O God, into something strong, enduring, and unified.
God My Refuge	Psalm 625-8
Reflection	What is God calling you to trust?
Prayer Prompt	Protect us and steady us in this time of change.

Jesus Washes Feet	John 131–17
Reflection	How can you serve and care for others in this season?
Prayer Prompt	Make me like Christ in times of change.
Peter's Confession	Matthew 1613–20
Reflection	What names for Christ help center and encourage you?
Prayer Prompt	Jesus, Messiah, help us build on the truth of who you are.
The Early Church Grows	Acts 237–47
Reflection	What can we learn from the early church's faith and practices?
Prayer Prompt	Strengthen our witness, even now, Most Generous Savior.
A Wise Builder	Matthew 724–27
Reflection	What does it look like for you to build your life on the words and person of Jesus?
Prayer Prompt	Jesus, make me wise. Steady me with your truth and promises.

## Week Three

Abram Steps Out in Faith	Genesis 121–9
Reflection	What new place or journey is God calling you to move toward?
Prayer Prompt	Covenant Keeper, give me courage to walk with you, even without all the answers.
A New Leader Rises	Joshua 11–9
Reflection	What does it mean to be strong and courageous today?
Prayer Prompt	Lead us, God, just as you led your people through every age and change.
Jesus Calls Peter Again	John 2115–19
Reflection	How is God calling you and your congregation into a new chapter of ministry?
Prayer Prompt	Help us hear your call and follow. Guide us, our staff, and church leaders.
The Road to Emmaus	Luke 2413–35
Reflection	When has Christ walked beside you in hard times?
Prayer Prompt	Holy One, open our eyes to your presence on the road ahead.
The Call of Ananias	Acts 910–19
Reflection	What does it look like to welcome the unexpected?
Prayer Prompt	Merciful One, give us faith to receive what you are doing.

## Week Four

A Church That Grows	1 Corinthians 35–11
Reflection	What does it mean to trust God with our church's future?
Prayer Prompt	Grow what you've planted here, God. We trust you with the harvest.
Calming the Storm	Matthew 823–27
Reflection	Where do you need peace right now?
Prayer Prompt	Jesus, speak peace into the storms of change and unknowing.
Paul and Barnabas Are Sent	Acts 131–3
Reflection	What might it look like to bless someone who is leaving?
Prayer Prompt	Help me release with love and bless with grace.
A Time for Everything	Ecclesiastes 31-8
Reflection	What season is your heart in right now— grieving, letting go, hoping, beginning again? How might God be at work in this new time for you and our church?
Prayer Prompt	God of all seasons, help me to trust you are present in every time of life— both the letting go and the starting anew. Inspire our church to move through this season with grace, wisdom, faith, and hope.
Pressing On Toward the Goal	Philippians 312–14
Reflection	What does it mean to move forward with hope?
Prayer Prompt	Holy Spirit, give us strength to keep moving forward in faith with you.
