It is bordered by Bangladesh and India to its northwest, China to its northwest, Laos and Thailand to its east and southeast, and the Andaman Sea and the Bay of Bengal to its south and southwest. The country's capital city is Naypyidaw, and its largest city is Yangon (Rangoon). Early civilisations in the area included the Tibeto-Burman-speaking Pyu city-states in Upper Myanmar and the Mon kingdoms in Lower Myanmar. In the 9th century, the Bamar people entered the upper Irrawaddy valley, and following the establishment of the Pagan Kingdom in the 1050s, the Burmase language, culture, and Theravada Buddhism slowly became dominant in the country. In the 16th Churty, reunified by the Taungoo dynasty, the country became the largest empire in the history of Southeast Asia for a short period.
