Thank you for your purchase of a Pembroke Welsh Corgi puppy. Corgis are very smart, sassy and loving dogs that are equally at home on the ranch or in your home. Good with children and adults alike, Corgis grow up to be beloved members of the family if given love, attention and training from the time they are young. Your puppy is registerable with the American Kennel Club, at your expense. Necessary information and application for registration is included with this contract.

It is very important that your puppy receive regular health check-ups, worming and vaccinations. Your puppy received its first worming at ~2 weeks and then additional worming every 2 weeks thereafter. This should be continued every 2 weeks until 4 months of age. Your puppy received its first vaccination at 4 weeks of age; it's second at 6 weeks and 3rd at 8 weeks. The next vaccinations should be given at 12 weeks of age and continued every month or by your veterinarian's instructions until the pup reaches 4 months of age.

Health Guarantee

This puppy has had a thorough health check through the seller's veterinarian. The seller certifies that this puppy is current on vaccinations and de-worming, and is, to the best of seller's knowledge in good physical health. For this guarantee to be valid, it is the buyer's responsibility to take the puppy to a state licensed veterinarian within 5 days of purchase for an examination, at the buyer's expense. If the veterinarian finds the puppy in good health OR if the buyer fails to have an examination within 5 days, the seller will assume no further responsibility. Should the veterinarian find a serious health concern (not to include: umbilical or inguinal hernia, cherry eye, undescended testicle, under or overbite) with the puppy, the buyer must notify the seller within the 5 day period and provide a written diagnosis from the examining veterinarian. (If parvo is suspected, a diagnosis must be diagnosed through a blood test.) The buyer agrees to make the puppy available to the seller's veterinarian for a second opinion within 2 days of notification of a health concern. If the same health concern is detected by the seller's veterinarian, the buyer may exchange the puppy for a similar one, pending availability, or may receive a full refund of the purchase price. Treatable conditions do not warrant an exchange of puppy. Should the buyer decide to keep the puppy, all expense and responsibility will be the buyer's from this point forward. Seller is not responsible for any vet bills or expenses. *This guarantee does not cover death, illness or injury resulting from abuse or neglect on the part of the buyer.*
