Infrastructure for Disconnected Edge Scenarios Christopher Perez, Principal Program Manager for Azure Global Microsoft

Preventing the Hack: Destruction and Creation Application in Security:

How driving in your car has taught you the skills you need to help you mitigate security issues. Defenders have always been thought to be at a disadvantage since we have to prevent the attack. With the new generation of tools, we now have the advantage. 90% of time in an attack is spent in the Observe, Orient and Decide phases of the decision cycle, while only 10% of the time is spent in the Attack phase itself. By harnessing lessons from physical threat management and applying these to Infrastructure security, we can disrupt the threat actor's Decision Cycle to stop them from compromising your organization. With the addition of IoT devices for monitoring of our infrastructures we all need to be aware of Cyber security and the impacts we can have on our organizations.

About the Speaker

Jeffrey Cady [CISSP] is currently employed as an Advisor for Infrastructure Security Engineering at Puget Sound Energy. Throughout his 20+ year career, he has tirelessly pushed the limits of technology platforms; including Voice, Data-Center, and Security. He has driven organizations beyond what was once presumed impossible, helping to establish new industry best-practices, quality guidelines, and standard operating procedures within IT Engineering. Jeff has repeatedly proven that current game-theory practices fall short, as they are implicitly reactive. His methodology realigns organizations to focus on prevention first & foremost through application of proven systems in decision loops and asymmetric warfare.
