Experienced Division

If an athlete meets any of the following criteria they must compete in the experienced division and cannot compete in the novice competition.

- 1. they are currently a grade 11 or 12 student, with a minimum of one year of wrestling experience
- They place in the top 4 at any tournament last year: O'niel, Saskatoon, RHSAA Cities or SHSAA Provincials.

The experienced division will run in pool format, with each pool consisting of a maximum of 5 athletes. Pools will be based on athlete scratch weight.

Novice Division

If an athlete does not fit the criteria for the experienced division, they wrestle in the novice division. This division may only contain wrestlers from 0 to 1 year total experience in wrestling. Wrestlers will be in pools of 5 based on weight and school affiliation. Note: If the numbers for the tournament are higher than previous years, we may switch to pools of 6 to save time.

Athletes may only wrestle in one division.

Medals will be awarded to the top competitor in each pool. Medals will be given to coaches to distribute at their discretion.

Weigh-ins

We will wrestle based on pools formed nearest in true or scratch weight. We will be using the TRACK wrestling application for all registries. The invite will be sent out prior to the tournament via email.

The tournament registry will close at *9:00 pm Friday night*. No new entrants will be added after the cutoff. Only scratches will be allowed the Saturday of competition, and you will not be charged for the scratch if it is made to our drawmaster prior to 8:30 am. Pools will not be redrawn unless there are only 2 remaining athletes per pool. If you will miss the deadline for some reason, you must email Rob Koroluk prior to the registry closing so we can make arrangements with the drawmaster.

Coaches:

Weights must be conducted off-site using a proper scale and weights/athlete **BE** names must be digitally received in TRACK WRESTLING ONLY. **SPORT** Emailed, hand written or faxed weights will not be accepted. Email me if there are any issues with your TRACK WRESTLING REGISTRY.
