Dear Neighbors,

As we start Autumn, the neighborhood is bustling with activities. Schools are back in session. There are after school activities, recreational sports, families walking with and without dogs, and a simple leaf or two falling to the ground. Times seem almost familiar. As each of us are aware, the variants for Covid-19 are changing and spreading. As we all make wise and safe choices heading into the winter months and holidays the DVIA is making plans to keep active also.

Currently, the corner property at 1215 York Road and Greenridge Road has signage listing the property for lease/sale. The current owners have not reached out to the DVIA Board regarding any potential requested changes for zoning. Although the final Comprehensive Zoning Map Process (CZMP) in August 2020 changed the property to Business Local (BL) the owners can ask for changes. We have not seen any request being made for this property.

During the summer many neighbors experienced finding dead birds, bunnies, mice, or squirrels. As reported from Department of Natural Resources this was throughout the Maryland and Virginia regions. Folks were asked to clean bird feeders regularly or stop using them. In recent weeks, there have not been any complaints shared with the DVIA Board. Hopefully, this has been self-resolving.

As a community we have learned how to function and care for each neighbor through this pandemic. The upcoming Halloween holiday will again leave families wondering what the best solution for the children who will be trick-or-treating. As with last year, the board has decided that each family who would like to participate should spread out candy on tables at the sidewalk or get creative with a socially distant distribution system. Families can walk their children through the neighborhood on the sidewalk. We ask that trick or treaters do not knock on doors. This allows us to keep a safe distance and celebrate a fun evening for all involved, including children who will not have the opportunity to be fully vaccinated before Halloween. I would like to hear from the community regarding the good things you witnessed or experienced during the past 18 months. I know one of our neighbors, the Baird family, has organized, collected, and delivered over 155,000 PBJ sandwiches, casseroles, desserts, and snacks for Our Daily Bread. 
