2019 Budget and Dues Increase

With the approved 2019 Budget you will notice a monthly dues increase of \$25 which makes the monthly dues \$171. The dues increase not come without without much analytics and discussion from the board. The dues increase will take effect January 1, 2019. Please make the necessary adjustments with your payment for January 1st payments. Remember if you have any questions use the action items to contact the management company through the action items.

Parking Permit
