Rules & Regulations for Sanctioned Events

- 1. All of the above events are sanctioned by the Eastern United States Pipe Band Association (EUSPBA), except 601. All competitors in sanctioned events must be a member in good standing of the EUSPBA or other recognized piping association. All EUSPBA rules and regulations apply. Visit www.euspba.org for rules, regulations, or membership forms.
- The contest committee reserves the right to cancel any and all events.
- 3. Entries must be postmarked by May 30, 2020.
- 4. Registration will begin at 8:30 a.m. Competition is tentatively scheduled to begin at 9:00 a.m. on June 13, 2020. A tentative competition schedule will be posted on the internet at www.pennpiob.org by June 10, 2020. Generally, Grades 5,4, and 3 will be in the morning with Grades 2&1 in the afternoon.
- 5. The competitions will be held rain or shine.
- 6. All competitors (except Novice Practice Chanter) must compete in appropriate highland attire.
- Gr. IV is split into two separate categories according to age: 17 & Under (Jr.) and Age 18 & Over (Sr.). See EUSPBA rules for details.
- Competitors in Gr. IV Piobaireachd must play a Full Piobaireachd in the contest.
- Order of play will be determined by the reverse order in which entries are received. The first entry received will be the last to play.
- 10. Awards will be given for first through third place in each event. The judge has the right to award one less prize than the number of competitors.
- 11. An overall trophy will be awarded to a piper in each grade (Grades 1 through 4). The winner will be determined by points with 1st Place = 3 points, 2nd Place = 2 points, 3rd Place = 1 point with Piobaireachd, then 2/4 March (or MSR) breaking any ties.
- 12. All protests should be made in writing and lodged with the Contest Committee before the end of the games day. All protests shall be dealt with by the Contest Committee, whose decision shall be binding by all parties concerned.
