### Placement Ideas

- Cornerstone blocks where borders meet
- Centers of star blocks or other traditional patterns
- Binding accents where they add a pop of interest
- Labels or hanging pockets for more subtle inclusions



## Creative Approaches


- Create a "window" to your past by framing the fabric
- Use the fabric as the center of a medallion or focus block
- Incorporate it alongside current projects to show your style evolution
- Use it in appliqué elements where exact matching isn't required
