

TOURNAMENT FORMAT (NHL'94)

(Formats are subject to change to ensure the best competition based on the number of participants and amount of equipment available)

1. Round Robin ("RR") groups will be determined by the tournament organizers. Every effort will be made to balance groups between new and veteran tournament players.

2. Players will play 6 RR games and at least 2 playoff games. Each player will play an equal number of home and away games in their RR group.

3. Once the RR is completed, players will be seeded for the playoffs.

Seeding for all brackets will be determined in the following order:

- Wins
- Total Goal Differential
- Fewest allowed goals
- The player who registered for the tournament the earliest. (Hey, it's better than a coin flip!)

4. Playoffs – Changed from last tournament

King of 94 Bracket – Will consist of players with 4 or more RR wins.

- It is a double-elimination format. Series are best-of-3, until you lose a series and move to the "second chance" side of the bracket. The second chance series are single games.
- The "second chance" side final will be a Best-of-3.
- The Championship Final will be a best-of-5 series with the winner's side finalist starting with a 1-0 series lead.

Duke of 94 Bracket – Will consist of players with 2 or 3 RR wins.

Puke of 94 Bracket – Will consist of players with 0 or 1 RR win.

- All players in the **Duke of 94** and **Puke of 94** tournaments will move to their own playoffs in Best of 1, double elimination format.

Lord of 94 Bracket - All players in the **Lord of 94** tournament will move to their own playoffs in Best of 3, single elimination format.
