John's Law, SB1309, involves families at critical points in Arizona's system for involuntary psychiatric treatment, including during screening, petition, evaluation, admission, and court-ordered treatment. SB1309 mandates mental health agencies to collect critically important information from families, guardians, and others who have a significant relationship with the patient during involuntary psychiatric screening and evaluation.



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
