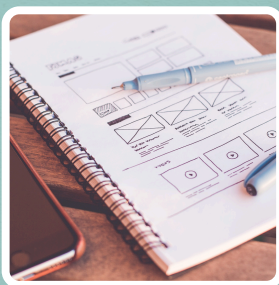

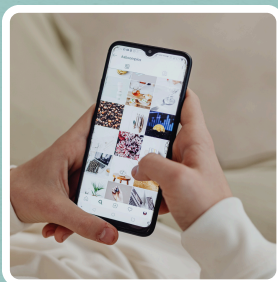
Progress Tracking
