The Autism Institute for Learning and Development (AILD) is a specialized homeschool learning program designed to support the academic, social, and developmental needs of students with autism and other learning differences. Founded by educator Eillim Cintron, AILD combines individualized instruction, hands-on learning, and family partnership to create an environment where every child can thrive.

Our program offers flexible learning options ranging from digital curriculum support to in-person learning pod experiences, allowing families to choose the level of support that best fits their child's needs.

Students receive carefully selected academic content in core subjects, including ELA, Math, Science, Social Studies, and Spanish, along with opportunities for enrichment in Art, STEM, Life Skills, and Physical Education.

At AILD, we believe education should nurture the whole child. Through individualized lesson planning, small group learning opportunities, field trips, and parent collaboration, we help students build confidence, strengthen academic skills, and develop independence in a supportive and engaging environment.

AILD partners closely with families by providing progress reports, educational consulting, and strategies that empower parents to actively support their child's learning journey.

REMOTE ONLY OPTIONS:

DIGITAL ONLY: **\$150**

Monthly study units (ELA, Math, Social Studies, Science, & Spanish) uploaded to the Google Classroom each month, and access to online learning platforms. This option also includes grading, progress reports and end of year evaluation.



\$200

PRINT ONLY:

Monthly study units (ELA, Math, Social Studies, Science, & Spanish) are provided to you in print form. Must be picked up at AILD HQ on prescheduled pick-up dates. This option also includes grading, progress reports, and end of year evaluation. Additional cost for mailing.

No access to online platforms and no materials included.

DIGITAL + PRINT + MATERIALS: **\$400**

Monthly study units (ELA, Math, Social Studies, Science, & Spanish) are uploaded to the Google Classroom each month, and access to online learning platforms is provided. Printed units and materials needed to complete all work. Must be picked up at AILD HQ on prescheduled pick-up dates. This option also includes grading, progress reports, and end of year evaluation. Additional cost for mailing.

DROP OFF & FIELD TRIPS OPTIONS

DIGITAL + PRINT + MATERIALS + FIELD TRIPS:

\$650

Everything in the previous option plus 1 field trip per month, Weekly 1-hour academic consultation and planning session (with appt on M&W-9 am-4:30 pm), monthly newsletter, and access to field trips only group chat, IEP Case review, and attendance to 1 IEP meeting (additional costs for IEP advocacy beyond that)

FULL PROGRAM WITH DROP OFF OPTION:

\$850

This option includes digital access to Google Classroom and Online Learning Platforms, printed content, and materials. Courses include - ELA, Math, Social Studies, Science, Spanish, Art, PE, Life Skills, & STEM. In addition, the full-time program will have drop-off at ALLD HQ on Tuesdays and Thursdays, 9 am – 1 pm. This program also includes educational consulting and support, IEP advocacy (up to 5 hours), Individualized lessons, weekly newsletter, group chat access, 1 monthly field trip (On Fridays from October -April) with student ticket paid for by ALLD, lunch/snacks during drop off days and Field trips, Live teacher support on M&W 9 am-4:30 pm, monthly parent folder with strategies and resources.

This option also includes assessments, grading, and progress reports and end of year evaluation.

IEP ADVOCACY & CONSULTING PACKAGE:

\$375

- This service provides comprehensive support to help families navigate the IEP process with confidence and clarity. We work collaboratively with parents to review, prepare, and advocate for appropriate educational services tailored to their child's needs.

This package includes up to 5 hours of consulting services, which may include:

- Review and analysis of educational records and IEP documents
- Case development and strategic planning
- Communication with the school (emails and/or phone calls)
- Ongoing parent consultation and guidance
- IEP Meeting Representation:
- This package also includes attendance at one (1) IEP meeting (virtual or in-person) to support and advocate on behalf of the family, ensuring that student's needs are appropriately addressed and that parents feel confident and supported during the process.
- Additional Time: Any time exceeding the initial 5 hours will be billed at a rate of \$50 per hour.

This service fulfills the annual evaluation requirement for homeschool students in Florida.

Autism (ASD) Screening – \$350

Dyslexia + ADHD Screening – \$250

This service provides comprehensive screening to identify potential indicators of Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), Attention-Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), and Dyslexia. Screenings are designed to help families better understand their child's strengths and areas of concern, and to determine whether further formal evaluation or support may be needed.

This service includes a comprehensive screening process, which may include:

- Review of developmental, educational, and behavioral history
- Parent interview and intake consultation
- Administration of evidence-based screening tools and rating scales
- Observation of the child (when applicable)
- Analysis of results across developmental, academic, and behavioral domains
