FOSTER WITH THE INTENT TO ADOPT

By law, rescues cannot adopt out any animal that is not spayed / neutered. Therefore, if the puppy or dog you are interested in adopting is not fixed at the time you bring him or her home, this application will be considered a <u>Foster With Intent to Adopt (FIA)</u> application. An FIA's responsibilities include bringing the dog to our veterinarian (at SHAR's cost) when:

- Vaccinations are due.
- The dog is ready to be spayed or neutered, which will take place between the ages of 12 16 weeks old.
- The dog is in need of routine medical attention (excluding the dog getting hurt while in your home)

When the "foster with intent to adopt" contract is signed, the full adoption fee will be given. However, the adoption is not finalized until the dog is spayed / neutered.

Should you fail to keep the rescheduled spay / neuter appointment, SHAR reserves the right to take possession of the dog, at which time the adoption fee will **NOT** be refunded.

In the event that SHAR incurs any costs or expenses in connection with securing payment of the adoption fees set forth above from you, you agree to pay all reasonable attorney's fees and collection costs.

Note that while fostering with the intent to adopt, ownership of the dog resides with SHAR. Only after the full adoption fee is paid and an adoption contract has been signed will ownership of the dog be transferred to you
