ADVICE FOR CLUBS

Suitable accommodation should be provided for Referees and Appointed Assistant Referees and their fees should be handed to them without delay after the match.

Secretaries are advised to check when they register a transferred player to determine whether or not he is cup-tied.

Financial charges are made by County Football Associations when players are cautioned or sent off. This charge shall be paid by the player's club within the stipulated time and the club is responsible for collecting same from the player. Should the player refuse to pay the club the amount due the club shall inform the County F A concerned. **FAILURE OF A CLUB TO PAY AND COMPLETE THE APPROPRIATE PAPERWORK IN ALL RESPECTS WILL RESULT IN EXTRA FINES AND SUSPENSION OF THE CLUB BY THE COUNTY F A.**

A "bounced cheque" means payment not received and extra fines.

ADVICE CONTINUED

Secretaries must submit a Referee mark for **every** match commenced and a Match Report Form for **every home** match commenced.

Registrations by the F A Whole Game System (WGS) must be received and accepted by the League Registration Secretary at least 2 days before the player plays in a League Match or an Emergency Registration by WGS can be used in **League Matches** to be received and accepted within 2 days of completion of the match.

Both Clubs must text results of their matches by 1.30pm for morning matches, 5.00pm for afternoon matches and by 9.30pm for evening matches using the FA FULLTIME SYSTEM. **CLUBS WILL BE FINED AT LEAST £10 PER OCCASION IF SCORE IS NOT RECEIVED BY THE DEADLINE.**

Clubs must text their results as above when involved in outside cup competitions.

Advice on any **postponements** must be texted **as soon as possible using the FULLTIME SYSTEM.**

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KIDDERMINSTER AND DISTRICT FOOTBALL LEAGUE RULES

DEFINITIONS

1. (A) In these Rules:

“Affiliated Association” means an Association accorded the status of an Affiliated Association under the rules of The FA.

“AGM” shall mean the annual general meeting held in accordance with the constitution of the Competition.

“Club” means a club for the time being in membership of the Competition.

“Competition” means the Kidderminster and District Football League.

“Competition Match” means any match played or to be played under the jurisdiction of the Competition.

“Contract Player” means any Player (other than a Player on a Scholarship) who is eligible to play under a written contract of employment with a Club.

“Deposit” means a sum of money deposited with the Competition as part of the requirements of membership of the Competition.

“Fees Tariff” means a list of fees approved by the Clubs at a general meeting to be levied by the Management Committee for any matters for which fees are payable under the Rules, as set out at Schedule A.

“Fines Tariff” means a list of fines approved by the Clubs at a general meeting to be levied by the Management Committee for any breach of the Rules, as set out at Schedule A.

“Ground” means the ground on which the Club’s Team(s) plays its Competition Matches.

“Management Committee” means in the case of a Competition which is an unincorporated association the management committee elected to manage the running of the Competition and where the Competition is incorporated it means the Board of Directors appointed in accordance with the articles of association of that company.

“Match Officials” means the referee, the assistant referees and any fourth official appointed to a Competition Match.

“Non Contract Player” means any Player (other than a Player on a Scholarship) who is eligible to play for a Club but has not entered into a written contract of employment.

“Officer” means an individual who is appointed or elected to a position in a Club or Competition which requires that individual to make day to day decisions.

“Participant” shall have the same meaning as set out in the rules of The FA from time to time.

“Player” means any Contract Player, Non Contract Player or other player who plays or who is eligible to play for a Club.

“Player Registration System” means The FA system to register players as determined by The FA from time to time.

“Playing Season” means the period between the date on which the first competitive fixture in the Competition is played each year until the date on which the last competitive fixture in the Competition is played.

“Rules” means these rules under which the Competition is administered.

“Sanctioning Authority” means the Worcestershire County Football Association Limited.

“Scholarship” means a Scholarship as set out in Rule C3.1.1 of the rules of The FA.

“Season” means the period of time between one AGM and the next AGM

“Secretary” means such person or persons appointed or elected to carry out the administration of the Competition.

“SGM” means a special general meeting held in accordance with the constitution of the Competition.

“Team” means a team affiliated to a Club, including where a Club provides more than one team in the Competition in accordance with the Rules.

“The FA” means The Football Association Limited.

“Virtual Meetings” means meetings held electronically

“written” or “in writing” means the representation or reproduction of words or symbols or other information in a visible form by any method or combination of methods, whether sent or supplied in electronic form or otherwise.

(B) Unless stated otherwise, terms referring to natural persons are applicable to both genders. Any term in the singular applies to the plural and also the other way around.

GOVERNANCE RULES

COMPETITION NAME, CONSTITUTION

2. (A) The Competition will be known as “Kidderminster and District Football League” (or such other name as the Competition may adopt). The Clubs participating in the Competition must be members of the Competition. A Club which ceases to exist or which ceases to be entitled to play in the Competition for any reason whatsoever shall automatically cease to be a member of the Competition.

(B) This Competition shall consist of not more than 200 Clubs approved by the Sanctioning Authority.

(C) The geographical area covered by the Competition membership shall be Worcestershire, Shropshire and Staffordshire.

(D) The administration of the Competition under these Rules will be carried out by the Management Committee in accordance with the rules, regulations and policies of The FA.

(E) All Clubs shall adhere to the Rules. Every Club shall be deemed, as a member of the Competition to have accepted the Rules and to have agreed to abide by the decisions of the Management Committee in relation to them, subject to the provisions of Rule 7.

(F) The Rules are taken from the Standard Code of Rules (the “Standard Code”) determined by The FA from time to time. In the event of any omissions from the Standard Code then the requirements of the Standard Code shall be deemed to apply to the Competition.

(G) 1. All Clubs must be affiliated to an Affiliated Association and their names and particulars shall be returned annually by the appointed date in a manner prescribed by the Sanctioning Authority and must have a constitution approved by the Sanctioning Authority. Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

2. This Competition shall apply annually for sanction to the Sanctioning Authority and the constituent Teams of Clubs may be grouped in divisions not exceeding 18 in number.

(H) Inclusivity and Non-discrimination

1. The Competition and each Club must be committed to promoting inclusivity and to eliminating all forms of discrimination and should abide and adhere to The FA Equality Policy and any legislative requirements (including those contained in the Equality Act 2010).

2. This Competition and each Club must make every effort to promote equality by treating people fairly and with respect, by recognising that inequalities may exist, by taking steps to address them and by providing access and opportunities for all members of the community, irrespective of age, gender, gender reassignment, sexual orientation, marital status, race,

nationality, ethnic origin, colour, religion or belief, ability or disability or otherwise.

3. Any alleged breach of the Equality Act 2010 legislation must be referred to the appropriate Sanctioning Authority for investigation.

(I) Clubs must comply with the provisions of any initiatives of The FA which are adopted by the Competition including, but not limited to, Charter Standard and RESPECT programmes. Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

(J) All Participants shall abide by The Football Association Regulations for Safeguarding Children and Regulations for Safeguarding Adults at Risk as determined by The FA from time to time.

(K) Clubs shall not enter any of their Teams playing in the Competition in any other competitions (with the exception of FA and County FA Competitions) except with the written consent of the Management Committee. Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

(L) At the AGM or an SGM called for the purpose, a majority of the delegates present shall have power to decide or adjust the constitution of the divisions at their discretion. When necessary this Rule shall take precedence over Rule 22.

(M) Only one Team from a Club shall be permitted to participate in a single division unless there is no viable alternative because of logistical issues and/or reasons linked to participation and geographical boundaries in which case the Competition will obtain the prior approval of the Sanctioning Authority. This Competition will ensure that, where permission is given, Teams from a Club operating in the same division are run as separate entities with no interchange of players other than by transfers of registration in accordance with these Rules.

CLUB NAME

3. Any Club wishing to change its name must obtain permission from the Sanctioning Authority following consultation with the Competition. In the event that permission is granted, the Club must advise the Competition Secretary. Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

ENTRY FEE, SUBSCRIPTION, DEPOSIT

4. (A) Applications by Clubs for admission to the Competition or the entry of an additional Team(s) from the same Club must be made in writing to the Secretary and must be accompanied by an Entry Fee for each Team as set out in the Fees Tariff, which shall be returned in the event of non-election.

Applications, of which due notice has been given, will be received at the AGM or an SGM if confirmed by a majority of the accredited voting members present.

When Rule 22.B is applied or a Team seeks a transfer or, is compulsorily transferred to another division, no Entry Fee shall be payable.

(B) The annual subscription shall be payable, in accordance with the Fees Tariff for team payable at a date agreed at the AGM or set by the Competition.

(C) In the event of any issue concerning the membership of any Club with the Competition the Management Committee may require a Deposit to be paid (in accordance with the Fees Tariff) by or on behalf of the Club on such terms and for such period as it may in its entire discretion think fit. Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

(D) A Club shall not participate in this Competition until the entry fee, annual subscription and deposit (if required) have been paid.

(E) Clubs must advise the Secretary annually in writing by the end of June of its Sanctioning Authority affiliation number for the forthcoming Playing Season. Clubs must advise the Secretary in writing, or on the prescribed form, of details of its headquarters, its Officers and any other information required by the Competition. Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

MANAGEMENT, NOMINATION, ELECTION

5. (A) The Management Committee shall comprise the Officers of the Competition and 11 members who shall all be elected at the AGM.

The 11 members shall comprise five members who shall not be connected with any member Club, one Referees' Representative and a maximum of five Club Representatives.

(B) Retiring Officers shall be eligible to become candidates for re-election without nomination provided that the Officer notifies the Secretary in writing not later than the end of April in each year. All other candidates for election as Officers of the Competition or members of the Management Committee shall be nominated to the Secretary in writing, signed by the secretaries of two Clubs, not later than the end of April in each year. Names of the candidates for election shall be circulated with the notice of the AGM. In the event of there being no nomination for any office by the date stated in the earlier part of this Rule, nominations may be received at the AGM.

(C) The Management Committee shall meet a minimum of twice a season or as and when required,

On receiving a requisition signed by two-thirds (2/3) of the members of the Management Committee the Secretary shall convene a meeting of the Management Committee.

(D) Except where otherwise mentioned all communications shall be addressed to the Secretary who shall conduct the correspondence of the Competition and keep a record of its proceedings.

(E) All communications received from Clubs must be conducted through their Officers and sent to the Secretary. Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

POWERS OF MANAGEMENT

6. (A) The Management Committee may appoint sub-committees and delegate such of their powers as they deem necessary. The decisions of all sub-committees shall be reported to the Management Committee for ratification. The Management Committee shall have power to deal only with matters within the Competition and not for any matters of misconduct that are under the jurisdiction of The FA or Affiliated Association.

(B) Subject to the permission of the Sanctioning Authority having been obtained, the Management Committee may order a match or matches to be played each Season, the proceeds to be devoted to the funds of the Competition and, if necessary, may call on each Club to contribute equally such sums as may be necessary to meet any deficiency at the end of the Season.

(C) Each member of the Management Committee shall have the right to attend and vote at all Management Committee meetings and have one vote at all such meetings but no member shall be allowed to vote on any matters directly relating to that member or to the Club so represented or where there may be a conflict of interest. (This shall also apply to the procedure of any sub-committee).

(D) In the event of the voting being equal on any matter, the Chair shall have a second or casting vote.

(E) The Management Committee shall have powers to apply, act upon and enforce these Rules

and shall also have jurisdiction over all matters affecting the Competition. Any action by the Competition must be taken within 28 days of the Competition being notified.

With the exception of Rules 6.J, 8.H, and 9, for all alleged breaches of a Rule the Management Committee shall issue a formal written charge to the Club concerned. The Club charged shall be given 7 days from the date of notification of the charge to reply. In such reply a Club may:

1. Accept the charge and /or submit in writing a case of mitigation for consideration by the Management Committee; or
2. Accept the charge and notify the Competition that it wishes to put its case of mitigation at a hearing before the Management Committee; or
3. Deny the charge and submit in writing supporting evidence for consideration by the Management Committee; or
4. Deny the charge and notify the Competition that it wishes to have a hearing before the Management Committee.

Where the Club charged fails to respond within 7 days, the Management Committee shall determine the charge in such manner and upon such evidence as it considers appropriate.

Having considered the reply of the Club (whether in writing or at a hearing), the Management Committee shall make its decision and, in the event that the charge is accepted or, proven, decide on the appropriate penalty (with reference to the Fines Tariff where applicable).

Where required, hearings shall take place as soon as reasonably practicable following receipt of the reply of the Club as more fully set out above.

With the exception of Teams playing at Regional NLS Feeder League of the National League System, the maximum fine permitted for any breach of a Rule is £250 and, when setting any fine, the Management Committee must ensure that the penalty is proportional to the offence; taking into account any mitigating circumstances.

The maximum fine permitted for a breach of a Rule by a Team playing at Regional NLS Feeder League level is £500.

No Participant under the age of 18 can be fined.

All breaches of the Laws of the Game, or the Rules and Regulations of The FA shall be dealt with in accordance with FA Rules by the appropriate sanctioning Association.

(F) All decisions of the Management Committee shall be binding subject to the right of appeal in accordance with Rule 7.

Decisions of the Management Committee must be notified in writing to those concerned within 7 days.

(G) A minimum of 50% of its members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business by the Management Committee or any of its sub-committees.

(H) The Management Committee, as it may deem necessary, shall have power to fill any vacancies that may occur in their number.

(I) A Club must comply with an order or instruction of the Management Committee and must attend to the business and/or the correspondence of the Competition to the satisfaction of the Management Committee. Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

(J) Subject to a Club's right of appeal in accordance with Rule 7 below, all fines and charges must be paid within 14 days of the date of notification of the decision. Any Club failing to do so will be fined in accordance with the Fines Tariff. Further failure to pay the fine including the additional fine within a further 14 days will result in fixtures being withdrawn until such time as the outstanding fines are paid.

- (K) A member of the Management Committee appointed by the Competition to attend a meeting or Competition Match may have any reasonable expenses incurred refunded by the Competition.
- (L) The Management Committee shall have the power to fill any vacancy that may occur in the membership of the Competition between the AGM or SGM called to decide the constitution and the commencement of the Playing Season.
- (M) The business of the Competition as determined by the Management Committee may be transacted by electronic mail or facsimile.

PROTESTS, CLAIMS, COMPLAINTS, APPEALS

7. (A) 1. All questions of eligibility, qualification of Players or interpretations of the Rules shall be referred to the Management Committee or a sub-committee duly appointed by the Management Committee.
2. Objections relevant to the dimensions of the pitch, goals, flag posts or other facilities will not be entertained by the Management Committee unless a protest is lodged with the referee prior to the commencement of the Match..
- (B) Except in cases where the Management Committee decide that there are special circumstances, protests and complaints (which must contain full particulars of the grounds upon which they are founded) must be lodged with the Secretary within 7 days (excluding Sundays) of the Competition Match or occurrence to which they refer. A protest or complaint shall not be withdrawn except by permission of the Management Committee. A member of the Management Committee who is a member of any Club involved shall not be present (except as a witness or representative of his Club) when such protest or complaint is being determined.
- (C) No protest of whatever kind shall be considered by the Management Committee unless the complaining Club shall have deposited with the Secretary a sum in accordance with the Fees Tariff. This may be forfeited in whole or in part in the event of the complaining or protesting Club losing its case. The Competition shall have power to order the defaulting Club or the Club making a losing or frivolous protest or complaint to pay the expenses of the inquiry or to order that the costs to be shared by the parties.
- (D) All parties to a protest or complaint must receive a copy of the submission and must be afforded an opportunity to make a statement at least 7 days before the protest or complaint being heard.
1. All parties must have received a minimum of 7 days' notice of the hearing should they be instructed to attend.
2. Should a Club elect to state its case in person then it should indicate such when forwarding the written response.
- (E) The Management Committee shall also have power to compel any party to the protest to pay such expenses as the Management Committee shall direct.
- (F) Any appeal against a decision of the Management Committee must be lodged with the Sanctioning Authority within 14 days of the posting of the written notification of the decision causing the appeal, accompanied by a fee (as set out in the Fees Tariff), which may be forfeited in the event of the appeal not being upheld. A copy of the appeal must also be sent to the Secretary. The procedure for the appeal shall be determined by the Sanctioning Authority, and the Sanctioning Authority may (but is not obliged to):
1. invite submissions by the parties involved;
 2. convene a hearing to hear the appeal;
 3. permit new evidence; or

4. impose appropriate deadlines.

Any appeal shall not involve a rehearing of the evidence considered by the Management Committee.

(G) No appeal can be lodged against a decision taken at an AGM or SGM unless this is on the ground of unconstitutional conduct.

(H) All protests, claims or complaints relating to these Rules and appeals arising from a Player's contract shall be heard and determined by the Management Committee, or a sub-committee duly appointed by the Management Committee. The Clubs or Players protesting, appealing, claiming or complaining must send a copy of such protest, appeal, claim or complaint and deposit a fee (as set out in the Fees Tariff) which shall be forfeited in the event of the protest, appeal, claim or complaint not being upheld, and in these circumstances may, in addition, be ordered to pay the costs at the direction of the Management Committee.

All such protests, claims, complaints and appeals must be received in writing by the Secretary within 14 days of the event or decision causing any of these to be submitted.

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

8. (A) The AGM shall be held not later than 30th June in each year. At this meeting the following business shall be transacted provided that at least 20 members are present and entitled to vote:-

1. Confirm the minutes of the last AGM.
2. Adopt the annual report, balance sheet and statement of accounts from the previous season or accounting period.
3. Election of Clubs to fill vacancies.
4. Constitution of the Competition for the ensuing Season.
5. Election of Competition Officers and Management Committee members.
6. Appointment of auditors/verifiers..
7. Alteration of Rules, if any (see Rule 14).
8. Agree the date for the beginning of the Playing Season and kick off times applicable to the Competition.
9. Agree the date for the end of the Playing Season (save for Regional NLS Feeder League which shall be determined by The FA).
10. Other business of which due notice shall have been given and accepted by the Chair as being relevant to an AGM.

(B) A copy of the duly audited/verified balance sheet, statement of accounts and agenda shall be forwarded to each Club at least 14 days prior to the meeting, together with any proposed Rule changes.

(C) A signed copy of the duly audited/verified balance sheet and statement of accounts shall be sent to the Sanctioning Authority within 14 days of its adoption by the AGM.

(D) Each Club shall be empowered to send two delegates to an AGM. Each Club shall be entitled to one vote only. 14 days' notice shall be given of any AGM.

(E) Clubs who have withdrawn their membership of the Competition during the Playing Season being concluded or who are not continuing membership shall be entitled to attend but shall vote only on matters relating to the Season being concluded. This provision will not apply to Clubs expelled in accordance with Rule 12.

(F) All voting shall be conducted by a show of hands, or count of email or virtual responses (for virtual meetings), unless a ballot be demanded by at least 50% of the delegates qualified to vote or the Chair so decides.

(G) No individual shall be entitled to vote on behalf of more than one Club.

(H) Any continuing Club must be represented at the AGM. Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

(I) Officers of the Competition and Management Committee members shall be entitled to attend and vote at an AGM.

(J) Where a Competition is an incorporated entity, the Officers of the Competition shall ensure that the Articles of Association of the Competition are consistent with the requirements of these Rules.

SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING

9. (A) On receiving a requisition signed by two-thirds (2/3) of the Clubs in membership the Secretary shall call an SGM.

(B) The Management Committee may call an SGM at any time.

(C) At least 7 days' notice shall be given of a meeting under this Rule, together with an agenda of the business to be transacted at such meeting.

(D) Each Club shall be empowered to send two delegates to all SGMs. Each Club shall be entitled to one vote only.

(E) Any Club failing to be represented at an SGM shall be fined in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

(F) Officers of the Competition and Management Committee members shall be entitled to attend and vote at all SGMs.

AGREEMENT TO BE SIGNED

10. Each Club shall complete and sign the following agreement which shall be deposited with the Competition together with the application for membership for the coming Season, "We,

(A) _____ of _____ Chairman/Director

and

(B) _____ of _____ Secretary

of the Football Club _____

have been provided with a copy of the Rules and Regulations of the Competition and do hereby agree for and on behalf of the said Club, if elected or accepted into membership, to conform to those Rules and Regulations and to accept, abide by and implement the decisions of the Management Committee of the Competition, subject to the right of appeal in accordance with Rule 7."

The agreement shall be signed:

1. where a Club is an unincorporated association, by the Club Chair and Secretary; or

2. where a Club is an incorporated entity, by two directors of the Club.

Any change of Chair, Secretary or Directors of the Club as named on the above agreement must be notified to the County Football Association to which the Club is sanctioned and to the Secretary of this Competition.

Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

CONTINUATION OF MEMBERSHIP, WITHDRAWAL OF A CLUB

11. (A) Any Club intending, or having a provisional intention, to withdraw a Team from the Competition on completion of its fixtures and fulfilment of all other obligations to the Competition must notify the Secretary in writing of such intention by 31st March each season. This does not apply to a Club moving in accordance with Rule 22.B. Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

(B) The Management Committee shall have the discretion to deal with a Team being unable to start or complete its fixtures for a Playing Season, including, but not limited to, issuing a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

(C) Notwithstanding the powers of the Management Committee pursuant to Rule 6.I, in the event of a Club failing to discharge all its financial obligations to the Competition in excess of £50, the Management Committee shall be empowered to refer the debt under The FA Football Debt Recovery provisions.

EXCLUSION OF CLUBS, TEAMS. MISCONDUCT OF CLUBS, OFFICERS, PLAYERS, MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

12. (A) At the AGM or SGM called for the purpose in accordance with the provisions of Rule 9, notice of motion having been duly circulated on the agenda by direction of the Management Committee, the accredited delegates present shall have the power to:

(1) remove a member of the Management Committee from office; (2) exclude any Club or Team from membership. both of which, must be supported by more than two thirds (2/3) of those present and voting. Voting on this point shall be conducted by ballot. A member of the Management Committee or Club which is the subject of the vote being taken shall be excluded from voting.

(B) At the AGM, or at an SGM called for the purpose in accordance with the provisions of Rule 9, the accredited delegates present shall have the power to exclude from further participation in the Competition any Club whose conduct has, in their opinion, been undesirable, provided this is supported by more than two-thirds (2/3) of those present and voting. Voting on this point shall be conducted by ballot. A Club whose conduct is the subject of the vote being taken shall be excluded from voting.

(C) Any Officer or member of a Club found guilty of either a breach of Rule, other than field offences, or of inducing or attempting to induce a Player or Players of another Club in the Competition to join them shall be liable to such penalty as a General Meeting or Management Committee may decide, and their Club shall also be liable to expulsion in accordance with the provisions of 12.A and/or 12.B of this Rule.

TROPHY

13. (A) The following agreement shall be signed on behalf of the winners of the cup or trophy:

“We (A) _____ and (B) _____, the Chair and Secretary of _____ FC (Limited), members of and representing the Club, having been declared winners of cup or trophy, and the cup or trophy having been delivered to us by the Competition, do hereby on behalf of the Club jointly and severally agree to return the cup or trophy to the Competition Secretary on or before the end of December. If the cup or trophy is lost or damaged whilst under our care we agree to refund to the Competition the amount of its current value or the cost of its thorough repair.”

Clubs shall have the same responsibility for any cup or trophy awarded to a Club individual.

Clubs returning a trophy late and/or not engraved shall bear the cost of engraving. Failure to comply will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

(B) At the close of each Competition awards shall be made to the winners and runners-up if the funds of the Competition permit.

ALTERATION TO RULES

14. (A) Alterations, for which consent has been given by the Sanctioning Authority, shall be made to these Rules only at the AGM or at an SGM specially convened for the purpose called in accordance with Rule 9. Any alteration made during the Playing Season to these Rules shall not take effect until the following Playing Season.

(B) Notice of proposed alterations to be considered at the AGM shall be submitted to the Secretary by 30th April in each year. The proposals, together with any proposals by the Management Committee, shall be circulated to the Clubs by the end of the first week in May and any amendments to these proposals shall be submitted to the Secretary by 21st May. The proposals and proposed amendments to these proposals shall be circulated to Clubs with the notice of the AGM. A proposal to change a Rule shall be carried if a majority of those present and entitled to vote and voting are in favour.

(C) A copy of the proposed alterations to Rules to be considered at the AGM or SGM shall be submitted to the Sanctioning Authority or The FA (as applicable) at least 28 days prior to the date of the meeting.

FINANCE

15. (A) The Management Committee shall determine with which bank or other financial institution the funds of the Competition will be lodged.

(B) All expenditure in excess of £1,000 shall be approved by the Management Committee. Cheques shall be signed by at least two Officers nominated by the Management Committee.

(C) The financial year of the Competition will end on 30th April.

(D) The accounting records or a certified balance sheet, of a Competition shall be prepared and shall be verified annually by a suitably qualified person(s) who shall be appointed at the AGM.

INSURANCE

16. (A) All Clubs must have valid Public Liability Insurance cover for a minimum of ten million pounds (£10,000,000) at all times.

(B) All Clubs must have valid personal accident cover for all Players registered with them from time to time. The Players' Personal Accident Insurance cover must be in place prior to the Club taking part in any Competition Match and shall be at least equal to the minimum recommended cover determined from time to time by the Sanctioning Authority. In instances where The FA is the Sanctioning Authority, the minimum recommended cover will be the cover required by the Affiliated Association to which a Club affiliates.

(C) Failure to comply with Rule 16.A or 16.B will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

DISSOLUTION

17. (A) Dissolution of the Competition shall be by resolution approved at an SGM by a majority of three quarters (3/4) of the members present and shall take effect from the date of the relevant SGM.

(B) In the event of the dissolution of the Competition, the members of the Management Committee are responsible for the winding up of the assets and liabilities of the Competition.

(C) The Management Committee shall deal with any surplus assets as follows:

1. Any surplus assets (save for a trophy or any other presentation), remaining after the discharge of the debts and liabilities of the Competition shall be transferred only to another Competition or Affiliated Association or The Football Association Benevolent Fund or to such other charitable or benevolent object in the locality of the Competition as determined by resolution at or before the time of winding up, and approved in writing by the Sanctioning Authority.

2. If a Competition is discontinued for any reason a trophy or any other presentation shall be returned to the donor if the conditions attached to it so provide or, if not, dealt with as the Sanctioning Authority may decide.

MATCH RELATED RULES

QUALIFICATION OF PLAYERS

18. (A) A Player is one who, being in all other respects eligible, has:

1. Registered through the Player Registration System and received approval from the Competition. except in the case of a Player who has been registered on the day of a match. For any players registered on the day of a match, a Club Officer must email the Competition with details of the registration as soon as possible. The Player shall not play again in any subsequent match in the Competition until the Club has registered the player through The FA Player Registration system and is in possession of the approval from the Competition. A maximum of 2 Players may be registered in this manner.

If a Club attempts to register a player via the Player Registration System but does not fully and correctly complete the necessary information via the Player Registration System the registration will not be processed.

Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

(B) 1. Contract players are not permitted in this Competition with the exception of those Players who are registered under Contract with the same Club who have a team operating at Steps 1 to 6 of the National League System.

2. It is the responsibility of each Club to ensure that any Player registered to the Club has, where necessary, the required International Transfer Certificate. Clearance is required for any Player aged 10 and over crossing borders including Wales, Scotland and Ireland.

3. Each team must have at least 12 Players registered 14 days before the start of each Playing Season. Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff..

(C) A Player that owes a Football Debt (as defined under the Football Debt Recovery Regulations) shall be permitted to register for a Club but will be suspended from football activities if the Player does not comply with the terms of the Football Debt Recovery Regulations in respect of that Football Debt.

(D) A fee as set out in the Fees Tariff shall be paid by each Club/Team for each Player registered.

(E) The Management Committee shall decide all registration disputes.

In the event of a player signing a registration form or having a registration submitted for more than one Club, priority of registration shall decide for which Club the Player shall be registered. The Registration Secretary shall notify the Club last applying to register the player of the fact of

the previous registration.

(F) It shall be a breach of Rule for a Player to:

1. Play for more than one Club in the Competition in the same Playing Season without first being transferred.
2. Having registered for one Club in the Competition, register for another Club in the Competition in that Playing Season except for the purpose of a transfer.
3. Submit a signed registration form as per Rule 18 A.2 or submit a registration through the Player Registration System that the Player had willfully neglected to accurately or fully complete.

Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

- (G) 1. The Management Committee shall have the power to accept the registration of any Player subject to the provisions of Rules 18.G.2 and 18.G.3 below.
2. The Management Committee shall have power to refuse, cancel or suspend the registration of any Player or may fine any Player, at their discretion (in accordance with the Fines Tariff) who has been charged and found guilty of registration irregularities (subject to Rule 7).
3. The Management Committee shall have power to make application to refuse or cancel the registration of any Player charged and found guilty of undesirable conduct (subject to Rule 7) subject to the right of appeal to the Sanctioning Authority. Application should be made to the parent County of the Club the Player is registered or intending to be registered with.

Undesirable conduct shall mean an incident of repeated proven misconduct, which may deter a Participant from being involved in this Competition.

4. A Player who has previously had a registration removed in accordance with Rule 18.G.3 but has a registration accepted at the expiry of exclusion will be considered to be under a probationary period of 12 months. Whilst under a probationary period, should the Player commit a further act of proven misconduct under the jurisdiction of the Competition, (excluding standard dismissals), the Competition may consider a further charge of bringing the Competition into disrepute.

(Note: Action under Rule 18.G.3 shall not be taken against a Player for misconduct until the matter has been dealt with by the Sanctioning Authority, and then only in cases of the Player bringing the Competition into disrepute and will in any event be subject to an appeal to the Sanctioning Authority or The FA. All decisions must include the period of restriction. For the purpose of this Rule, bringing the Competition into disrepute can only be considered where the Player has received in excess of 112 days' suspension, or 10 matches in match based discipline, in any competition (and is not restricted to the Competition) in a period of two years or less from the date of the first offence.)

(H) Subject to compliance with FA Rule C2 (a) when a Club wishes to register a player who is already registered with another club it shall submit a transfer notification to the Competition via the Player Registration System. A fee as set out in the Fees Tariff will be required.

Such transfer shall be referred by the Competition to the club for which the player is registered. Should this club object to the transfer it should state its objections in writing to the Competition and to the player concerned within 3 days of receipt of the notification. Upon receipt of the club's consent, or upon its failure to give written objection within 3 days, the Secretary may, on behalf of the Management Committee, transfer the player who shall be deemed eligible to play for the new Club from such date or 2 days after receipt of such transfer.

In the event of an objection to a transfer the matter shall be referred to the Management Committee for a decision.

In the event of a Non Contract Player without a written contract changing his status to that of a Contract Player with the same Club, another Club in the Competition or with a club in another competition their registration as a Non Contract Player will automatically be cancelled and declared void unless the Club conforms to the exception detailed in Rule 18.B.1.

(I) A Player may not be registered for a Club nor transferred to another Club in the Competition after 31st March except by special permission of the Management Committee.

(J) Registrations are valid for one Playing Season only.

A Club shall keep a list of Players it registers and a record of all matches in which those Players have played and shall produce such records upon demand by the Management Committee.

Clubs having more than one team in the Competition must send the names of their 13 senior side/s players to the Registration Secretary 48 hours before their first match and not later than 1st September.

(K) A Player shall not be eligible to play for a Team in any special championship, promotion or relegation deciding Competition Match (as specified in Rule (22.A) unless the Player has played 1 Competition Matches for that Team in the current Playing Season.

(L) A Team shall not include more than 3 Players who have taken part in 1 or more senior Competition Matches during the current Playing Season unless a period of 21 days has elapsed since they last played.

For the purpose of this Rule a senior competition(s) is a higher Division in the League.

Clubs having more than one Team in the Competition must send the names of their 13 senior side Players to the Registration Secretary 48 hours before their first match and not later than 1st September.

Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

(M) 1. Subject to Rule 18.M.2 any Club found to have played an ineligible Player in a Competition Match or Matches where points are awarded shall have the points gained from that Competition Match deducted from its record, up to a maximum of 12 points, and have levied upon it a fine (in accordance with the Fines Tariff).

2. The Management Committee may vary the sanction as relates to the deduction of points set out at Rule 18.M.1 only in circumstances where the ineligibility is due to the failure to obtain an International Transfer Certificate or where the ineligibility is related to the Player's status.

3. Where a Club is found to have played an ineligible Player in accordance with Rule 18.M.1 above, the Management Committee may also, at its discretion:

- a) Award the points available in the Competition Match in question to the opponents, subject to the Competition Match not being ordered to be replayed; or
- b) Levy penalty points against the Club in default; or
- c) Order that such Competition Match or Matches be replayed (on such terms as are decided by the Management Committee).

(N) The following clause applies to Competitions involving Players in full-time secondary education:

1. Priority must be given at all times to activities of schools and school organisations. Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

2. The availability of children and young people must be cleared with the Head Teachers or Principals (except for Sunday leagues competitions).

3. To play open age football the player must have achieved the age of 16.
- (O) A Player who has played for a Team in a higher division 3 times or more shall not in that Playing Season be eligible to play in a lower division except by permission of the Management Committee.

CLUB COLOURS

19. (A) Every team must register the colour of its shirts and shorts with the Secretary by 15th June and the Competition Secretary shall decide as to their suitability.
- (B) Any team changing its colours during the Playing Season must notify the Competition Secretary immediately.
- (C) Goalkeepers must wear colours which distinguish them from all other Players and the Match Officials.
- (D) No Player, including the goalkeeper, shall be permitted to wear black or very dark shirts.
- (E) Any Team not being able to play in its normal colours as registered with the Competition shall notify its opponents of the colours in which they will play (including the colours of the goalkeepers jersey) at least 3 days before the Competition Match.
- (F) If, in the opinion of the referee, two Teams have the same or similar colours, the Home Team shall make the change. Should a Team delay the scheduled time of kick off for a Competition Match by not having a change of colours they will be fined in accordance with the Fines Tariff.
- (G) Shirts must all be numbered and no two shirts shall have the same number, failing which a fine will be levied in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

PLAYING SEASON. CONDITIONS OF PLAY, TIMES OF KICK-OFF. POSTPONEMENTS. SUBSTITUTES

20. (A) All Competition Matches shall be played in accordance with the Laws of the Game as determined by the International Football Association Board.
- Clubs must take all reasonable precautions to keep their Grounds in a playable condition. All Competition Matches shall be played on pitches deemed suitable by the Management Committee. If through any fault of the home Team a match has to be replayed, the Management Committee shall have power to order the venue to be changed.
- The Management Committee shall have power to decide whether a pitch and/or facilities are suitable for Competition Matches and to order the Club concerned to play its Competition Match(es) on another ground.
- Football Turf Pitches (3G) are allowed in this Competition provided they meet the required performance standards and are listed on the FA's Register of Football Turf Pitches. All Football Turf Pitches used must be tested (by a FIFA accredited test institute) every three years and the results passed to The FA. The FA will give a decision on the suitability for use and add the pitch to the Register.
- The home Club is also responsible for advising Participants of footwear requirements when confirming match arrangements in accordance with Rule 20.C.
- Within the National League System ("NLS") all Competition Matches shall have a duration of 90 minutes. All Competition Matches outside of the NLS shall have duration of 90 minutes unless a shorter time (not less than sixty (60) minutes) is mutually arranged by the two Clubs in consultation with the referee prior to the commencement of the match, and in any event shall be of equal halves. Two matches involving the same two Teams can be played on the same day providing the total playing time is not more than 120 minutes.

The times of kick-off shall be agreed at the AGM and can only be altered by the mutual consent of the two competing Clubs and the Competition. Referees must order matches to commence at the appointed time and must report all late starts to the Competition.

Home Teams must ensure that their ground is accessible to Match Officials and Opponents at least 45 minutes prior to kick-off.

The home Team must provide goal nets, corner flags and at least four footballs fit for play and the referee shall make a report to the Competition If not provided. Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

(B) Except by permission of the Management Committee all Competition Matches must be played on the dates originally agreed but priority shall be given to The FA and parent County Association Cup Competitions. All other matches must be considered secondary. Clubs may mutually agree to bring forward a Competition match with the consent of the Competition. Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

In the case of a revised fixture date, the Clubs must be given by the Competition 5 clear days' notice of the match (unless otherwise mutually agreed).

(C) An Officer of the home Club must give notice of full particulars of the location of, and access to, the Ground and time of kick-off to the Match Officials and an Officer of the opposing Club at least 3 clear days prior to the playing of the match. If not so provided, the away Club shall seek such details and report the circumstances to the Competition. Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

(D) In accordance with the Laws of the Game, the minimum number of Players which will constitute a Team for a Competition Match is 7.

(E) 1. Home and away matches shall be played. In the event of a Club failing to keep its engagement the Management Committee shall have power to impose a fine (in accordance with the Fines Tariff), deduct points from the defaulting Club, award the points from the Competition Match in question to the opponents, order the defaulting Club to pay any reasonable expenses incurred by the opponents or otherwise deal with them except by the award of goals. Notwithstanding the foregoing home and away provision, the Management Committee shall have power to order a Competition Match to be played on a neutral ground or on the opponent's Ground if they are satisfied that such action is warranted by the circumstances.

2. Any Club with more than one Team in the Competition shall always fulfil its fixture, within the Competition, in the following order of precedence:- First Team, Reserve Team, A Team.

3. Any Club unable to fulfil a fixture or where a Competition Match has been postponed for any reason must, without delay, give notice to the Competition Secretary, Referees secretary and Fixtures Secretary, Secretary of the opposing Club and the Match Officials. Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

4. In the event of a Competition Match not being played or being abandoned owing to causes over which neither Club has control, it should be played in its entirety on a date to be mutually agreed by the two Clubs and approved by the Competition Failing such agreement and notification to the Competition within 7 days the Competition shall have the power to order the Match to be played on or before a given date. Where it is to the advantage of the Competition. the Management Committee shall also be empowered to order the score at the time of an abandonment to stand. Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

5. The Management Committee shall review all Competition Matches abandoned in cases where it is consequent upon the conduct of either or both Teams. Where it is to the advantage of the Competition and does no injustice to either Club, the Management Committee shall order the score at the time of the abandonment to stand. In all cases where the Management Committee are satisfied that a Match was abandoned owing to the conduct of one Team or its Club member(s) they shall award the points for the Match to the opponent. In cases where a Match has been abandoned owing to the conduct of both Teams or their Club member(s), the Management Committee shall rule that neither Team will be awarded any points for that Match and it shall not be replayed. No fine(s) can be applied by the Management Committee for an abandoned Match.

The Management Committee shall review any Match that has taken place where either or both Teams were under a suspension imposed upon them by The FA or Affiliated Association. In each case the Team that was under suspension would be dealt with in the same manner as if they had participated with ineligible players in accordance with Rule 18.M above. Where both Teams were under suspension the game must be declared null and void and shall not be replayed.

(F) A Club may at its discretion and in accordance with the Laws of the Game use substitute Players in any Competition Match. A Club may name up to 5 substitute Players. A player who has been substituted, himself becomes a substitute and may replace a player at any time.

The referee shall be informed of the names of the substitute Players not later than 5 minutes before the start of the Competition Match and a Player not so named may not take part in that Competition Match. Referees shall indicate on the Match Report Form (by circling the players' number) when a substitute has played.

A Player who has been named as a substitute before the start of the Competition Match but does not actually play in that game shall not be considered to have been a Player in that Competition Match within the meaning of Rule 18 of this Competition.

(G) The half time interval shall be of 5 minutes' duration, but it shall not exceed 15 minutes. The half time interval may only be altered with the consent of the referee.

(H) The Teams taking part in a Competition Match shall identify a Team captain who shall wear an armband and shall have a responsibility to offer support in the management of the on-field discipline of their teammates. Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

Prior to each match the participating Teams and Match Officials shall conduct the "RESPECT HANDSHAKE".

REPORTING RESULTS

21. (A) The Competition must receive within 2days of the date played, the result of each Competition Match in the prescribed manner. (ie by a completed Match Report Form) This must include the forename(s) and surname of the Team Players (in block letters) Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

(B) Both Clubs shall use FA Full Time / FA Matchday as directed by the Competition to notify the result of each Competition Match by 1.30pm for morning matches or within 1 hour of the end of the match for later kick-offs. Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff. If a Club is draw away in an external Cup Competition against a Team not in membership of the Kidderminster and District Football League, that Club shall also notify the Kidderminster and District F L as above.

(C) The match result notification, correctly completed, shall be signed by an Officer of the Team,

or as prescribed by the Competition. Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

The Competition shall have power to take such action as they deem suitable against a Club which submits an incomplete form or incorrect information. The Match Report Form must be presented by the Home Team for completion by their Opponents and Referee on a clip board or similar without delay following completion of the match. Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

DETERMINING CHAMPIONSHIP

22.(A) Team rankings within the Competition will be decided by points with three points to be awarded for a win and one point for a drawn Competition Match. The Teams gaining the highest number of points in their respective divisions at the end of the Playing Season shall be adjudged the winners. Competition Matches must not be played for double points.

In the event of two or more Teams being equal on points at the end of the Playing Season, rankings shall be determined by goal difference (where the goals scored against each Team shall be deducted from the goals scored by that Team and the Team with the most favourable goal difference shall be placed highest).

In the event of two or more Teams still being equal, the Team which has scored the most goals during the Playing Season shall be placed highest.

In the event of two or more Teams still being equal, the Team that has won the most matches during the Playing Season shall be placed highest.

In the event of two or more Teams still being equal, the Team which has the better playing record against the other Team in their head to head Competition Matches during the Playing Season will be placed highest.

If the records of two or more Teams are still equal and it is necessary for any reason to determine the position of each then the Teams affected shall play a deciding match or matches under conditions as determined by the Management Committee.

(B) Automatic promotion shall be applied for the first 2 Teams and automatic relegation shall be applied for the last 2 Teams in each division except as provided for below subject to the provisions of Rule 2.L.

1. Should one or more Teams withdraw from any one division after the Playing Season has commenced an equal number of Teams to those withdrawing in that division shall not be automatically relegated.

2. Vacancies occurring after the conclusion of the Playing Season may be filled in any of the following ways:

- a. retention of otherwise relegated Team(s); or
- b. additional promotion of the next ranked Team(s) from the division below; or
- c. election.

3. The last 2 Teams in the lowest division shall retire, but be eligible for re-election except as below, and be subject to the conditions of Rule 22.B.1 above.

4. When a senior Team is relegated to a lower division of which its reserve Team is a member, or entitled to be a member, such reserve Team must accept relegation to, or retain its position in, the next lower division; and should the senior Team be relegated to the lowest division its reserve Team automatically retires from the Competition.

5. Should either or both of the leading Teams in any of the divisions have its senior Team in the next higher division, promotion shall fall, at the discretion of the General Meeting,

to the next highest Team or Teams in the division concerned.

(C) In addition to the Team(s) automatically promoted under Rule 22.B, a maximum of one further Team shall be promoted by virtue of being the winner of a play-off match or series of matches (the "Play-Offs). The eligibility criteria and format of the Play-Offs are as follows.

(D) In the event of a Team withdrawing from the Competition before completing 75% of its fixtures for the Playing Season all points obtained by or recorded against such defaulting Team shall be expunged from the Competition table. For the purposes of this Rule 22.D a completed fixture shall include any Competition Match(es) which has been awarded by the Management Committee

MATCH OFFICIALS

23. (A) Registered referees (and assistant referees where approved by The FA or County FA) for all Competition Matches shall be appointed in a manner approved by the Management Committee and by the Sanctioning Authority.

Appointed Match Officials shall attend the ground at least 30 minutes prior to kick-off.

(B) 1. In the event of the non-appearance of the appointed referee the appointed senior assistant referee shall take charge and a substitute assistant referee appointed by the competing Teams.

2. In cases where there are no officially appointed Match Officials in attendance, the Clubs shall agree upon a referee. An individual thus agreed upon shall, for that Competition Match, have the full powers, status and authority of a registered referee. Individuals under the age of 16 must not participate either as a referee or assistant referee in any Competition Match.

(C) Where assistant referees are not appointed each Team shall provide a Club assistant referee. Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

(D) The appointed referee shall have power to decide as to the fitness of the Ground in all Competition Matches and that decision shall be final, subject to the determination of the Local Authority or the owners of a Ground, which must be accepted.

(E) Subject to any limits/provisions laid down by the Sanctioning Authority, Match Officials appointed under this Rule shall be paid a match fee in accordance with the Fees Tariff and travel expenses of 35 per mile with a maximum of £10 travel expenses. Appointed Assistant Referees shall be paid a fee and half the appropriate travel expenses.

Match Officials will be paid their fees and/or expenses by the home Club immediately after the Competition Match. If Assistant Referees are appointed both Clubs shall share the Assistant Referees fees and expenses with the Referee being responsible for collating the fees and expenses and presenting these to the Clubs.

Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

(F) In the event of a Competition Match not being played because of circumstances over which the Clubs have no control, the Match Officials, if present, shall be entitled to: Referee £10 only and Assistant Referees £5 only. Where a Competition Match is not played owing to one Club being in default, that Club shall be ordered to pay the Match Officials, if they attend the Ground, their full fee and expenses. Failure to comply with this Rule will result in a fine in accordance with the Fines Tariff.

(G) A referee not keeping their engagement, and failing to give a satisfactory explanation as to their non-appearance, may be reported to the Affiliated Association with which he or she is registered. A Referee unable to keep a scheduled appointment shall notify the Referees

Appointments Secretary and Home Club without delay, ensuring the intended recipient receives the message.

(H) Each Club shall, in a manner prescribed from time to time by The FA, award marks to the referee for each Competition Match and the name of the referee and the marks awarded shall be submitted to the Competition on the prescribed form provided. Clubs failing to comply with this Rule shall be liable to be fined (in accordance with the Fines Tariff) or dealt with as the Management Committee shall determine.

(I) The Competition shall keep a record of the markings and, on the form provided by the prescribed date each Season, shall submit a summary to the Sanctioning Authority.

(J) The referee shall complete the Match Report form, supplied by the Competition, giving the result of the Competition Match, the number of Players in each Team and the time of kick-off plus any other information asked for on the Form.

(K) Match Officials shall be supplied, each season, with a copy of the Competition Rules free of charge.

(L) Match Officials shall comply with the provisions of any initiatives of The FA and/or Sanctioning Authority adopted by the Competition

Match Officials shall wear uniforms comprising almost entirely of black shirts, shorts and socks.

RULES BINDING ON CLUBS

24 (A) Each member Club shall be deemed to have given its assent to the foregoing Rules and agreed to abide by the decision of the Management Committee, subject to Rule 7. Each Club must abide by any issued F A Code of Conduct.

(B) Each member Club shall agree to indemnify and keep indemnified the Officers and Members of the Management Committee and each and every one of them from and against all liability in respect of damage or injury to persons or to any property real or personal, moveable or immovable or any loss, damage or costs arising directly or indirectly out of any game or games of Association Football arranged or organized by or on behalf of the Competition.

RULES FOR LEAGUE CUP MATCHES
THESE RULES TO BE USED IN CONJUNCTION WITH LEAGUE RULES

1. Senior Cup Sunday for Sunday Premier and Division One Teams.
Junior Cup Sunday for Sunday Division Two and Division Three Teams.
2. The entire control and management shall be vested in the Management Committee.
3. The cups shall be completed for annually and shall not be won outright. Trophies will be given to the winners and finalists, funds permitting.
4. The entrance to the League Cups appropriate to the Division in which the Club plays is mandatory and the Clubs will be allowed to enter THREE other Cup Competitions (including County Cups).
Where a Club has more than one team the above will apply to each side. Clubs will be allowed to enter ONE team in each League Cup Competition. If the Club has two sides that qualify to play in one Section of the Competition, then the Senior side will take part and the Reserves will be allowed to enter an alternative Competition.
5. The entrance fee to all League Cups is £20.00 per team.
6. To be eligible to play in these Competitions a player must have played one League or Cup game for his Club or have been registered by the Registration Secretary at least 14 days prior to the tie taking place.
7. Clubs found guilty of playing ineligible player(s) may be fined and/or removed from the Competition.
8. A player who has played in the League Senior Sunday Cup is not eligible to play in the League Junior Sunday Cup. A player who has played in the League Junior Cup can play in the League Senior Cup but then will be unable to play in the League Junior Cup again.
9. The ties shall be drawn and played as ordered by the Management Committee, who shall also fix replays. At least five days notice shall be given to Clubs for notification of matches.
10. Fifteen minutes each way extra time shall be played in ALL rounds in the event of a draw at the end of 90 minutes and if the scores are still level the winners shall be decided by penalties taken in accordance with the Laws of the Game.

If mutually arranged by the two Clubs in consultation with the referee prior to the commencement of the match, extra time need not be played if the match is a draw after 90 minutes and the result can be determined by penalties. (As per Laws of the Game).
11. The kick-off times in all League Cup matches shall be 10.30 am. Home Clubs shall ensure that their ground is accessible to Match Officials and Opponents at least 45 minutes prior to kick-off.

12. In League Cup Final matches each participating Club shall supply two match balls to the Referee, which shall be to correct specification.

13. Senior Cup fees as Premier Division, Junior Cup and Minor Cup fees as other Divisions. Clubs shall share the Match Officials fees and expenses and these shall be paid immediately after the match.

A. The Referee, Assistant Referees and Fourth Official shall receive trophies in lieu of the fee in the Final Tie and will be allowed to claim expenses as per League Rule 13E, these expenses to be paid by the League.

14. The result and the names of the players competing in each tie shall be submitted to the Secretary on the form provided to be received within TWO days of the match otherwise Clubs will be fined £1.00 for the first offence, £2.00 for the second offence, £3.00 for the third offence etc.

15. Both Clubs must send a considered report on the Referee, on the form provided, within FIVE days of the match being played otherwise Clubs will be fined £1.00 for the first offence, £2.00 for the second offence, £3.00 for the third offence etc. and/or the Club being dealt with as the Management Committee decide.

16. Home Clubs must advise visiting Clubs: position of the ground, dressing rooms, Club colours etc., at least three clear days prior to the date on which the match is to be played. Clubs failing to do so will be dealt with by the Management Committee. In the event of a clash in colours the HOME side must change.

17. In the League Cup Competitions the semi-finals to be played on the ground of the first team out in the draw unless the Management Committee decides otherwise.

18. Finalists shall supply a list of players from whom their League Cup Final team shall be selected, to the League Secretary. The list to be received within two days following their semi-final match. Clubs failing to submit the list on time shall be fined.

19. A Club wishing to protest must do so within SEVEN days of the match taking place, or of notification of a Management Committee decision. Any Club protesting must submit £15.00 which will be returned if the protest is successful. In the event of further appeal against the decision of the League or the Management Committee, the appeal must be lodged with the Worcestershire Football Association within SEVEN days with a deposit of £25.00.

20. Winning Clubs shall sign a guarantee to return the trophy on demand.

21. Four Management Committee Members will be put in charge of each Final and be responsible for the gate, raffle and roping off of the ground, one member to be responsible for income and expenses.

22. In League Cup Final matches, in the event of a draw at the end of 90 minutes play an extra 15 minutes each way shall be played. If the scores are still level after extra time the winners shall be decided by penalties taken in accordance with the Laws of the Game.
23. Any contingency not covered by these Rules shall be dealt with by the Management Committee whose decision shall be final and binding on all parties.
24. Referees, Assistant Referees and Fourth Officials shall confirm League Cup Final appointments to the Referee Appointments Secretary within two days of receipt of the appointment.
25. Referees, Assistant Referees and Fourth Officials appointed to League Cup Finals shall attend at the ground at least 60 minutes prior to kick-off. Fourth Officials' fees and expenses as Assistant Referees.

**KIDDERMINSTER AND DISTRICT FOOTBALL LEAGUE
LEAGUE FIRE SHIELD COMPETITION**

To be competed for by Teams in the Kidderminster and District League.

The Rules of the Competition will be as the Kidderminster League Cup Competition with the exceptions as shown below.

1. The Competition will be open to all Sunday League Sides as decided by the Management Committee each season.
 - a. Clubs may enter their first team and their reserve teams into the competition but they must be as separate teams, this means that once a player has played for either the first team or the reserves then he cannot play for the other side.
 - b. Clubs entering their reserve team/s can only play three players at any one time from their more senior team(s).

**KIDDERMINSTER AND DISTRICT FOOTBALL LEAGUE
SUBSIDIARY CUP COMPETITIONS AND ROY MARCHANT MEMORIAL CUP.**

The Rules of these Competitions will be as for the Kidderminster League Cup Matches.

Referees and Assistant Referees (when appointed) fees and expenses will be as Premier Division if a Premier Division team is drawn at home; otherwise fees and expenses will be as for Other Divisions.

If the Competition commences on a mini-league basis then League Rules will apply for qualification of players. League Cup Rules will apply for qualification of players for knockout basis matches.

**“DOUBLE MATCHES”
TO EASE FIXTURE CONGESTION MATCHES MAY BE PLAYED AS “DOUBLES”**

Clubs wishing to play a match as a “DOUBLE” must obtain permission from the League Secretary and then inform the Referees’ appointments Secretary and any appointed match officials without delay.

A Double Match is a First Match (A V B) of 30 minutes each way duration followed by a Second Match (B V A) again of 30 minutes each way duration.

There is a 15 minutes interval between matches unless both clubs agree on a shorter period.

The two matches are separate games where different players can be used and any player sent off in the first match can take part in the second match.

Match report forms and referee report forms should be completed for each match as normal clearly indicating team “A” V Team “B” or Team “B” V Team “A”.

Match officials will be paid a fee for each match plus one lot of travelling expenses. This total amount should be paid to the officials by Team “A” and Team “B” will reimburse Team “A” half the amount paid.

Postponed matches will be dealt with by the League Management Committee in the normal way but if the Referee postpones one or both matches due to pitch conditions then the Match Officials are entitled to £10 (Referee), £5 (assistant Referee) if one match only is postponed or if both matches are postponed.

Kick Off Times: 10-30 am.

POSTPONEMENT OF FIXTURES

PROCEDURE TO BE ADOPTED WHEN POSTPONING A FIXTURE FOR PLAYING A CUP TIE ETC.

Postponing Club must obtain permission from League secretary and **after** receiving permission must give Fixtures Secretary, Referee Appointments Secretary, opponents and appointed officials (Referee and Assistant Referees) seven days' notice of postponement.

Note: - Opponents losing a fixture should check with League Fixtures Secretary **before** advising their players etc. as all attempts will be made to provide the team with a match.

PROCEDURE TO BE ADOPTED WHEN POSTPONING A FIXTURE DUE TO GROUND CONDITIONS.

Home Club should advise their **match referee** that there is a doubt about ground suitability. **This** referee will make arrangements for inspection with the club and will either inspect personally or will take the word of a local referee etc. **but** only the match referee can make the decision to postpone the match and the decision **cannot** be made more than 24 hours before the scheduled kick-off.

When the fixture is postponed the home club must, **without delay**, notify League Secretary, Fixtures Secretary and Referee Appointments Secretary, opponents and match officials.

If a postponement seems likely before the day of the match the home club should attempt to get the match played by finding another venue or agreeing to play on their opponents ground.

After League Secretary's approval to ground change the club changing the venue (original Home club) must notify opponents, Fixtures Secretary, Referee Appointments Secretary and match officials without delay.

When a postponement seems likely on the day of the match the home club should arrange for a pitch inspection in time to notify their opponents of the postponement to prevent unnecessary travelling. If a fixture is postponed on the match day the League Secretary must be notified as soon as possible and there will be no objection to clubs taking emergency action to get a match played by delaying kick-off time or moving the venue, etc.

If a referee is called in to make an early inspection he is entitled to travelling expenses if he would have normally returned home and travelled again to referee the match. If he inspects and would have normally stayed to referee if the ground had been suitable for play he is entitled to £10. If, of course, he does both, he is entitled to both, i.e. early inspection travelling expenses and £10 if he subsequently travels back and still has to postpone the match. If a match is postponed due to the fault of one of the teams, match officials are entitled to full fee and travelling expenses. (To be paid by the home team, who can claim reimbursement)

**KIDDERMINSTER CHARITY CUPS COMMITTEE “1992”
COMPETITION RULES**

1. The Competition shall comprise: THE KIDDERMINSTER HOSPITAL CUP COMPETITIONS and THE KIDDERMINSTER HARRIERS JUNIOR CUP.
2. The entire control and management of the Competition shall be vested in a Committee consisting of the Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer and up to ten other members.
3. The Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer for the time being shall be, for all intent and purpose, legal owners of cups, monies and properties of the Competitions and shall deal with the same accordingly to the directions of the Committee.
4. The cups shall be challenge cups and shall never be won outright and are the absolute property of the Kidderminster Charity Cups Competitions.
5. Committee members shall receive no remuneration for their services.
6. All clubs competing for the cups shall be members of a County Football Association.
7. The Competition for the cups shall be annual and shall be open to Junior Clubs. The Competitions are: Kidderminster Hospital Sunday Junior Cup and Sunday Minor Cup and Kidderminster Harriers Sunday Junior Cup.
8. Clubs desirous of competing in the Competitions must complete the appropriate Entry Form and this, together with the entry fee, must reach the Competition Secretary by the stated closing date. The entrance fee to all Competitions to be fixed at the Annual General Meeting. (Currently £20).
9. The names of Clubs entering the Competitions shall be placed by the Committee in the appropriate Cup, and shall be drawn in couples to compete with each other within the time specified by the Committee. The names of the winning Clubs shall be drawn in couples and compete as in the first tie and so on until the Final Tie is played when the winning Club shall hold the cup for the current year. The Final Tie shall take place under the direction of the Committee.
10. The ties shall be played according to County Conference dates or as the Committee may determine and after each drawing the Secretary shall inform each club the name of the club it is drawn against and the time within which the tie is to be played.
11. In the event of a club getting a bye in any round, the Committee at the next draw shall first draw a club to play against such a club.
12. Any club refusing to play the club which it has been drawn against, within the time intimated, without sufficient reason for doing so shall be adjudged to have forfeited the tie and fined £75. Clubs intending to scratch from the Competition shall give the Secretary of the

Competition and their opponents written notice of their intention to do so at least fourteen (14) days before the date fixed for playing the tie, failure to do so shall result in a £50 fine. Any club failing to give satisfactory reason for withdrawing from any competition shall not be allowed to enter that competition the following season.

13. The first team in each couple drawn shall have choice of ground. In the event of the game finishing in a draw at the end of 90 minutes play an extra 15 minutes each way shall be played. Should the game still be a draw after playing extra time the tie shall be decided by taking penalties in accordance with the Laws of the Game.

14. The half-time interval shall be of five minutes duration and this may only be altered with the consent of the match referee.

15. The home team shall be responsible for staging the match. The visitors are responsible for their own expenses. The home team shall notify their visitors of full particulars of the situation of the ground and their playing colours, the away team to acknowledge. Failure to carry out this instruction shall result in a fine. The home team must confirm all fixtures with the appointed match referee and appointed Assistant Referees by three days prior to the scheduled date of the tie. In case of a colour clash the home team will change. In all ties, except the Final tie, the clubs shall share the fees and expenses of match Officials. In the Final tie match Officials shall receive trophies as funds permit. In the event of a match not being played because of circumstances over which no club has control the match Referee, if present, shall be entitled to £10 only and Assistant Referees £5 only. If a match is not played owing to a club being at fault that club shall pay the Officials, if present at the ground, their full fee and expenses. Match Officials fees and expenses shall be as the appropriate Kidderminster and District Football League fees and expenses.

16. All shirts shall be numbered.

17. In the event of any match being postponed prior to the scheduled date the Club responsible for postponing must notify the Competition Secretary, the Referees Appointments Secretary and their opponents. Failure to inform as stated shall result in a fine.

18. The home team must provide at least four match balls, which shall be fit for play. The referee must report deficiencies and clubs shall be fined for failure.

19. In the Final Tie each team must supply 2 suitable match balls.

20. The Referees and Assistant Referees fees and expenses shall be those applying at the time in the Kidderminster & District Football League. Junior as Premier. Minor as others.

21. In the Final ties the Committee shall appoint grounds, manage proceedings and make arrangements for an admission charge. 20 free passes for entry to the ground will be issued to each of the participating clubs. These free passes will be used for the players taking part in the match and club officials. Members of the club in excess of this number will be charged full admission to the ground.

22. A club may, in accordance with the Laws of the Game, name five 5 substitute players in any match. The club shall be required to name these substitute players to the match referee at least 5 minutes prior to the start of play. A player who has been substituted, himself becomes a substitute and may replace a player at any time..
23. Except in the Final tie, notice of the result of each match with the names of the players shall be entered on the official Match Report Form and sent by the home club to the Competition Secretary to arrive within two days (Sundays excluded) of the date on which the match was played. Failure to carry out this instruction shall incur the club a fine. In the Final tie the names of the competing players shall be in the hands of the Competition Secretary or his deputy 30 minutes before the appointed kick off time otherwise the offending club shall be fined.
24. In all matches both teams must forward to the Referees' Appointments Secretary a considered mark on the form provided to be received within five days of the match being played. Failure to comply will result in a fine. Any club awarding the referee a low mark of 60 or less must send a written explanation to the Referees Appointments Secretary with the form.
25. Match Report Forms and Referee Report Forms must be correctly completed and clubs guilty of errors shall be fined.
26. In the Semi Finals and Final tie any club failing to play without showing sufficient reason may be adjudged by the Committee to be guilty of serious misconduct, struck from the Competition and be liable to be reported to their parent County Football Association. Winning Semi Finalists must forward their squad players names for the Final to the Competition Secretary to be received within 2 days of the Semi Final.
27. When the winning Club has been ascertained the cup shall be handed to their representative on receipt of an indemnity form signed by two substantial members of the club. The cup to be insured by the Competition.
28. The whole proceeds of the Finals shall go to the Competition Committee, which shall devote at least one third of the receipts to local charities. The remaining two thirds to become the property of the Competition from which all other receipts and necessary expenses shall be taken.
29. A bona fide player for the purpose of this Competition is: one who has played in a previous league match for his Club prior to the conference date of the cup tie or who has been registered as a player for his Club at least fourteen days prior to the conference date of the cup tie. Clubs playing an ineligible player shall be struck from the Competition and fined. No contract player may take part in the Competition. A player already having played for a team in the Competition may not play for another team in the Competition in the same season.
30. Further to the requirements of Rule 29, players must be registered with the Competition. A registered player for this Competition is one whose name has been submitted to the Competitions Secretary at least two days prior to the date of the match and is acceptable to the Secretary in all other aspects. For any infringement of this rule the offending team shall be fined and/or struck from the Competition.

31. No player may appear in the Final tie without having played in a previous round unless permission has been obtained from the Committee.
32. A player having played in the Minor Cup Competition may, during the same season, also play in the Junior Cup Competition but only for the same club. A player having played in the Junior Cup Competition cannot under any circumstance play in the Minor Cup Competition during the same season. For an infringement of this rule the team shall be struck from the Competition.
33. Players must be registered en-bloc on a registration form at the start of the Competition, subsequent registrations must be made in writing to the Competitions Secretary and the names will be added to the list of registered players.
34. The competing teams shall number not more than 11 players. Any team playing with less shall be fined.
35. The Committee shall appoint Referees and Assistant Referees where possible and these Officials shall be taken from the official list of registered Referees. In the event of no Assistant Referees being present, both Clubs shall appoint a Club Assistant Referee. If any club cannot provide a Club Assistant Referee their opponents shall have the liberty of providing the two. In the event of only one Assistant Referee being present the provision as to which club provides the other shall be decided by the toss of a coin in the presence of the Referee and an official of both sides
36. All questions of eligibility, qualifications of players, interpretation of the rules etc shall be referred to the Committee.
37. Protests and appeals must be lodged with the Competitions Secretary within seven days of the match, together with the sum of £15 which shall be forfeited to the Competition funds in the event of the protest or appeal not being upheld.
38. Should either of the two clubs in connection with the protest have a representative on the Committee, the said representative or official shall not be eligible to sit on the Committee while the protest is being discussed.
39. Any appeal against a decision of the Committee must be made within seven days of the notification of the decision together with sum of £15, which shall be forfeited, to the funds of the Competition in the event of the appeal not being upheld.
40. Any further appeal against a decision of the Committee must be made within seven days of notification of the decision to the Worcestershire Football Association together with the sum of £25 which shall be forfeited in the event of the appeal not being upheld.
41. The holders of any cup shall return it in good clean condition to the Competition Secretary before the end of December in the current season or on demand from the Committee.

42. In addition to the cup the Committee shall present trophies to the players of both teams in the Final tie as funds permit. Any player dismissed from the field of play for misconduct in the Final tie will have his trophy withheld. The player's Club may make written application to the Competition Secretary, to be received within seven days of the Final tie, that consideration be given by the Committee to allow the player to receive his trophy.
43. Clubs wishing to purchase additional trophies for players not appearing in the Final tie may do so only with the express permission of the Committee.
44. The Annual General Meeting shall be held in June or July of each year.
45. The Committee shall have power to vary or add to these rules as they may from time to time deem expedient subject to the terms of rule 45.
46. No changes to the rules shall be made except at the Annual General Meeting or at a meeting convened to carry out same. Any proposed alteration to be in the hands of the Competition Secretary at least 14 days prior to the meeting.

League Privacy Notice

Kidderminster and District Football League: we take your privacy very seriously.

This Privacy Notice sets out how we use and look after the personal information we collect from you. We are the data controller, responsible for the processing of any personal data you give us. We take reasonable care to keep your information secure and to prevent any unauthorised access to or use of it.

What personal data we hold on you

Personal data means any information about an individual from which that individual can be identified. We collect, use, store and transfer some personal data of our participants, and other League members.

You provide information about yourself and your members when you register with the League, and by filling in forms at an event or online, or by corresponding with us by phone, e-mail or otherwise.

The information you give us may include name, date of birth, address, e-mail address, phone number, gender, and the contact details of a third party in the case of emergency. We may also ask for relevant health information, which is classed as special category personal data, for the purposes of health, wellbeing, welfare and safeguarding. Where we hold this data it will be with the explicit consent of the participant or, if applicable, the participant's parent or guardian.

Where we need to collect personal data to fulfil League responsibilities and you do not provide that data, we may not be able honour or administer your registration.

Why we need your personal data

We will only use personal data for any purpose for which it has been specifically provided.

The reason we need participants' and members' personal data is to be able to run the football league and arrange matches; to administer registration, and provide the league services you are signing up to when you register with the League as a club or participant. Our lawful basis for processing this personal data is that we have a contractual obligation to anyone as a participant or member to provide the services they are registering for.

We have set out below, in a table format, a description of all the ways we plan to use personal data, and which of the legal bases we rely on to do so. We have also identified what our legitimate interests are where appropriate.

Who we share your personal data with

When you register with the League, your information, if you are a coach or volunteer will be or if you are another participant may be entered onto the Whole Game System database, which is administered by the FA. We also pass your information to the County FA/ FA for affiliation purposes.

We may share personal data with selected third parties, suppliers and sub-contractors such as, coaches or match organisers. Third-party service providers will only process your personal data for specified purposes and in accordance with our instructions.

We may disclose personal information to third parties to comply with a legal obligation; or to protect the rights, property, or safety of our participants, members or affiliates, or others.

The League's data processing may require personal data to be transferred outside of the UK. Where the League does transfer personal data overseas it is with the sufficient appropriate safeguards in place to ensure the security of that personal data.

Protection of your personal data

We have put in place appropriate security measures to prevent personal data from being accidentally lost, used or accessed in an unauthorised way, altered or disclosed.

How long we hold your personal data

We keep personal data on our participants while they continue to be a participant or are otherwise actively involved with the League. We will delete this data at the end of the current season after a participant has left or otherwise ended their registration or affiliation, or sooner if specifically requested and we are able to do so. We may need to retain some personal data for longer for legal or regulatory purposes. The personal data that is stored on Whole Game System is subject to the FA's privacy policy so we advise you review that policy together with this notice. If anyone would like their personal data to be deleted from Whole Game System then please contact the County FA.

Your rights regarding your personal data

As a data subject participants may have the right at any time to request access to, rectification or erasure of their personal data; to restrict or object to certain kinds of processing of their personal data, including direct marketing; to the portability of their personal data and to complain to the UK's data protection supervisory authority, the Information Commissioner's Office about the processing of their personal data.

As a data subject participants are not obliged to share their personal data with the League. If they choose not to share their personal data with us we may not be able to register them with the League.

We may update this Privacy Notice from time to time, and will inform you to any changes in how we handle personal data.
