



Background

About the Canton, St. Paul & Pacific Railway. Our Railway is unique in that the Railway owns the property. Many other clubs are in public parks or on the property of a private individual. The Railway is private and does not offer rides to the general public; however, we do enjoy engaging with fellow Railroad enthusiasts. All Railway guests must be invited and sponsored by a member. The Railway currently has 27 members. Nineteen of our members live in Georgia. Eight of our members live out-of-state. Our Railway is focused on steam locomotives. Although there are some diesel locomotives, steam locomotives out-number diesels.

Building the Railway

All track, switches, and trestles were built by the members. The rail is aluminum. The Railway owns a die and has a commercial extruder which extrudes the rail (usually a ton of aluminum). The rail is then anodized for appearance. Ties are rough cut pressure treated 2x2's. The rail is held to the ties with screws. There are 4 screws per tie, so the Railway used a lot of screws and ties. Track panels were fabricated at the base of the Railway and transported, via rail, to the end of the line.

Likewise, switches/turnouts were fabricated and transported via rail to the end of the line. As you travel around the Railway you will notice there is no road access to much of the right-of-way.

Riding our Railway

The Railway is a point-to-point configuration with loops at both ends. The Right-of-Way is single track with passing sidings. The Railway employs a "Capture and Release" signal system. The engineer manually actuates a switch when entering a passing siding, thus releasing the block. Likewise, the engineer captures the next block when exiting the passing siding. Engineers can proceed only on a green signal. A yellow signal indicates a train in the next block proceeding in the same direction of travel. A red signal indicates a train coming in the opposite direction.

Your trip, around our Railway will take 20-40 minutes depending on other traffic. Passenger cars are referred to as "T" cars. You straddle a bench with your feet on floor boards. Each passenger car is approximately 10' long. Three or four adults can sit on each passenger car. Your train will consist of 4 passenger cars. Motive power will be either a GP35 or a Dash 9 locomotive. These diesels have a two-cylinder gas engine powering a hydraulic system with hydraulic motors on each truck. All axels are powered.

While riding you need to stay centered in your seat and not lean or reach out. Feet need to stay on the foot boards. Please leave actuating the signals to the engineer. There are some YouTube videos of our Railway.

TWO "G Scale" CONVENTIONS IN 2025! By Ted Yarbrough

The National Garden Railway Convention will return in 2025 having been absent in 2024 because no club bid to host. Next year's event will be in Sacramento, California. Yes, it is all the way across the country, but will be well worth the effort and expense to attend. California's weather is ideal for garden railroading and Northern California has plenty of great layouts to see. The vendor hall will be packed with manufacturers and retailers, so there will be many bargains to be had. The BBQ will be held at the California State Railroad Museum. It is possibly the finest railroad museum in the United States! There will be a convention locomotive AND car. Matthew Abreu, the convention chairman, was in attendance at the recent Southeast Regional event here in Atlanta promoting the convention. The event will be June 18-22 and more info will be available shortly. I hope some GGRS members will attend.

The second convention is the Big Train Operators Club (BTO). Teya Caple-Woods, BTO board member, was also at our regional event promoting their 2025 convention. This group held a convention earlier this year, in the same Pennsylvania location as their 2022 event. 




Garden Railroader of the Year
