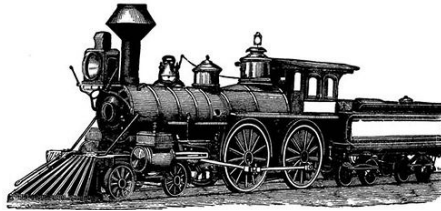

ACTIVITIES AND EVENTS



The Society starts the year in January with the election of Executive Board members and their installation at a regional restaurant. The meeting includes a voluntary gift swap and recognition of the previous year's **Garden Railroader of the Year**.

From January through April, the Society exhibits railway layouts at indoor train shows popular in the metro-Atlanta area using one of our traveling G-scale train layouts. Members can volunteer to set up or break down the exhibit, serve at our membership table, or assist running trains for short periods during these 1- or 2-day events.

Our most popular activities start about April with our hosted member meetings. Each month through about September, a GGRS family will host a potluck picnic luncheon at their home in order to showcase their particular garden railway. These usually occur on second Saturdays of the month from about 10:00 to 2:00. The meetings may also include a short clinic on some aspect of garden railroading. Group train excursions on regional scenic railroads are also popular and are scheduled once or twice a year.
