




3-Day Rolling Average







7-Day Moving Average



By State | June 1








Total COVID-19 Cases per 100,000 Residents

By State | November 27 (New Daily Cases in U.S. Peak)





By State | December 1










Population Growth

Largest 30 MSAs | 2018 vs 2019
















Employment Growth – Pre-COVID


Largest 30 MSAs | January 2019 vs 2020





Employment Growth – Onset of COVID







Unemployment Rates




Employment as Share of Pre-COVID Total




MSA Unemployment Rate vs. Percent Employed in Leisure/Hospitality vs. Size of Leisure/Hospitality Industry (May 2020)






MSA Unemployment Rate vs. Percent Employed in Leisure/Hospitality vs. Size of Leisure/Hospitality Industry (May 2020)






MSA Unemployment Rate vs. Percent Employed in Leisure/Hospitality vs. Size of Leisure/Hospitality Industry (October 2020)






MSA Unemployment Rate vs. Percent Employed in Leisure/Hospitality vs. Size of Leisure/Hospitality Industry (October 2020)






Nevada Unemployment Rate Has Dropped

10 Highest Unemployment Weeks in Nevada History



Historical 8-Week Periods






Share of Homes with Negative Equity






Nevada vs. US Not Paying Mortgage or Rent





WHEREAS, on March 12, 2020, I, Steve Sisolak, Governor of the State of Nevada issued a Declaration of Emergency to facilitate the State's response to the COVID-19 pandemic; and


WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, Donald J. Trump, President of the United States declared a nationwide emergency pursuant to Sec. 501(b) of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, 42 U.S.C. 5121-5207 (the "Stafford Act"); and

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization (WHO) and United States Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) have advised that there is a correlation between density of persons gathered and the risk of transmission of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, as of March 29, 2020, the State of Nevada Department of Health and Human Services is reporting 738 positive cases of COVID-19, and 15 deaths resulting from COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, close proximity to other persons is currently contraindicated by public health and medical best practices to combat COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, NRS 414.060 outlines powers and duties delegated to the Governor during the existence of a state of emergency, including without limitation, directing and controlling the conduct of the general public and the movement and cessation of movement of pedestrians and vehicular traffic during, before and after exercises or an emergency or disaster, public meetings or gatherings; and










Largest Year-Over-Year Visitor Volume Declines







By Month














U.S. Disposable Personal Income

Year-Over-Year Total Growth








U.S. M2 Money Supply

Year-Over-Year Total Growth








Nevada Total Personal Income Growth






Funds Used by Nevada Households in the Past 7 Days to Meet Spending Needs (Week Ending June 16)








Funds Used by Nevada Households in the Past 7 Days to Meet Spending Needs (Week Ending September 14)



















Projected 6th Grade Math Performance Scores













Health Concerns Growing With Ongoing Pandemic


















Employment vs White House Control



Job Growth vs White House Control






Annual Real GDP Growth








Annual Real GDP Growth and Presidents














Which Party's Control is Better for the U.S. Economy?


