

# TERMS AND CONDITIONS



In order to receive driving lessons, you must:

- Be aged 17 or older (16 or over if disabled)
- Hold a driving licence that is valid for the UK (provisional, full or an appropriate foreign licence)
- Meet the minimum driving eyesight standards\*<sup>1</sup>

## [\\*<sup>1</sup> - Gov.uk Driving eyesight rules](#)

*To legally drive a car (Group 1 licence) in the UK, you must be able to read a standard vehicle number plate from 20 metres away in good daylight. You must also have a visual acuity of at least decimal 0.5 (6/12) on the Snellen scale and an adequate field of vision.*

It is your responsibility to provide your instructor with proof that you have a valid licence to drive, and that you meet the eye sight standards. Your licence will be checked, both with the Gov.uk website\*<sup>2</sup>, and at the start of the first driving lesson, as well as an eye test. If you fail to provide a valid licence, and/or you fail the eye test, your Instructor is entitled to refuse to conduct the driving lesson, but may still charge you.

*\*<sup>2</sup> – Part of the driving licence details are now held online. In order for the Driving Instructor (or equivalent authority (eg. Police) to be able to check to ensure that the person is legally entitled to be on the road, a check code will be required prior to the start of the first lesson. This is a standard one-off driving licence background check. Instructions are given at the time of booking, or can be found at <https://www.gov.uk/view-driving-licence>, and the code created is valid for 21 days.*

These lessons will be conducted in a neutral area using the Driving Schools' software and equipment, and will be subject to the cancellation policy as below.

Lessons will be conducted using a manual, dual-controlled vehicle.

## CANCELLATION POLICY

You must give at least 48 hours' notice to your Instructor if you wish to cancel or re-arrange a booked driving/theory lesson. Failure to do so may result in your Instructor charging you the full amount for that lesson. A text will be sent advising of this policy upon the initial contact.

Your Instructor also reserves the right to refuse to conduct a lesson, if it is suspected that the pupil is under the influence of alcohol/drugs, and will also may result in you being charged the full amount for that lesson.
