




Two people leave a party a bit tipsy and ride home; one gets home fine, the other hits a pothole and breaks an arm.




Two workers make the same small
safety slip; one day nothing






Someone hungry and broke takes

supermarket and gets caught.




A parcel is delivered to the wrong house and the person keeps it because they think they'll get away with it.




A person walks past without saying hello and it feels like a deliberate act.




Someone interrupts you mid-story
and you feel dismissed.




Someone sits in your usual spot
and you feel pushed out.




Someone says “you’ve already
